

**Subject:** Miami-Dade Transit Ridership Report (December 2013)

Attached is the Miami-Dade Transit Monthly Ridership Report across all modes for December 2013. This reporting period spans three months of ridership data since the new fare increases took effect on October 1, 2013.


For the reporting period of December 2013, overall system average daily ridership registered a small increase over the December 2012 period, with an uptick of one-half of a percent. The 1.6% decrease in average weekday bus boardings was offset by an increase of 6.2% in Metrorail average weekday boardings and a 6.2% increase in Metromover average weekday boardings. STS realized a decrease of -2.8%. A slight decrease in STS boardings in the month of December is typical.

The largest increases in average weekday Metrorail boardings from December 2012 to December 2013 were registered at the following stations:

Metrorail Station Average Weekday Boardings	Percentage Increase	Boardings Increase
Brickell	21.2%	912
Government Center	6.5%	712
Dadeland South	8.4%	577

The largest increases in average weekday Metrobus boardings from December 2012 to December 2013 were registered on the following routes:

Metrobus Route Average Weekday Boardings	Percentage Increase	Boardings Increase
Route 38 (Dadeland South to Florida City via the Busway)	5.7%	454
Route 8 (FIU to Downtown via SW 8th Street)	4.7%	351
Route 297 (Miami Airport Metrorail to 27th Ave/NW 211th Street - Limited Stop)	19.6%	329
Route 88 (Dadeland North to 152nd/88th Street via Kendall Drive)	13.5%	322
