

SPONSORED BY THE MOUNT ZION AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$910.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 1 FY 2013-14 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND


