

We do hereby certify from said returns as follows:

**Bond Referendum for Parks Improvement and Expansion, Including Installing Crime Prevention Equipment**

Shall the City of Miami Gardens issue general obligation bonds not exceeding \$60,000,000, in one or more series, maturing not later than 30 years from their issuance dates, bearing interest not exceeding the maximum allowable by law, payable from City levied ad valorem taxes, for parks and crime prevention, including purchasing and installing crime prevention equipment, providing facilities for expanding community activities in parks, and renovating, constructing and purchasing parks facilities and land?
