

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source


There is no fiscal impact to the County.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY AND MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, THROUGH THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT RELATING TO ESTABLISHING PROTOCOLS AND PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY AT NAVY FACILITIES LOCATED IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE ACTION TO EXECUTE AMENDMENTS, MODIFICATIONS, RENEWALS, AND EXTENSIONS, TO EXERCISE THE CANCELLATION PROVISIONS AND TERMINATION CLAUSES CONTAINED THEREIN

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Department of the Navy has a long history of partnership with the Miami-Dade Police Department,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board finds it is in the best interest of Miami-Dade County to approve the execution of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of the Navy and Miami-Dade County, through the Miami-Dade Police Department, especially as relates to establishing protocols for the Miami-Dade Police Department to assist the Navy Operational Support Center, Miami, and United States Marine Corps 4th Civil Affairs Group Force Headquarters, in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof, and authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute memoranda of understanding and agreements for and on behalf of Miami-

Dade County, and to execute any amendments, modifications, renewals, and extensions of same, to exercise the cancellation provisions contained in the memoranda of understanding, and termination clauses of any contracts and agreements on behalf of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Subj: MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

(b) MCO 5530.14A

1. Purpose. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to establish protocols whereby Miami-Dade County, by and through its department, the Miami-Dade Police Department (MDPD) will assist the Navy Operational Support Center (NOSC), Miami and United States Marine Corps 4th Civil Affairs Group Force Headquarters Group (USMC) in responding to reported activation of the weapons storage alarm or intruder detection systems, at the facility located at 18650 NW 62nd Avenue, Hialeah, Florida, Miami-Dade County.

2. Duration of this Memorandum of Understanding. The MOU is effective on the date it is signed by the final Agency. It will continue in force for five years unless the parties terminate their participation by 30 day written notification and can be modified in writing by the parties upon mutual consent to meet operational necessity and statutory mandates.

3. Mission. The primary mission of the MDPD is to provide a law enforcement response to reported activation of the weapons storage alarm or intruder detection systems, at the facility located at 18650 NW 62nd Avenue, Hialeah, Florida, Miami-Dade County. The NOSC and USMC will facilitate MDPD by providing detailed information regarding the nature of the incident and access to the facility.

4. Supervision. MDPD will be solely responsible for the supervision of MDPD personnel and operational questions and necessities will be addressed by the supervisors of MDPD.

5. Operational Personnel. Contingent on operational necessity and manpower limitations, MDPD will provide a response to report activation of the weapons storage alarm or intruder detection systems at facility located at 18650 NW 62nd Avenue, Hialeah, Florida, Miami-Dade County, in a timely manner.

Subj: MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

6. Release of information to the Press. At no time will participating agencies release to/or discuss with any member of the press any aspect of operations or any aspect to/or reported activation of the weapons storage alarm or intruder detection systems at the facility located at 18650 NW 62nd Avenue, Hialeah, Florida, Miami-Dade County. Subsequent to the consultation, participating agencies will discuss any information release with the affected investigators and/or prosecutors to assure that the integrity of any investigation will not be jeopardized. In most, if not all cases, the release of any information, no matter how generic, will be made jointly with the participation of all the involved agencies, pursuant to Florida Statutes chapter 119, Public Records, or any applicable federal statutes.

7. No Private Right Created. This is an internal government MOU between all of the listed agencies; it is not intended to confer any right or benefit to any party.

8. Liability. Each agency shall bear the liability arising from acts undertaken by its personnel pursuant to this MOU. In no event shall a participating agency or political subdivision be liable for suit or claim for damages resulting from the acts of another participating agency. All tort liability regarding Miami-Dade County and its employees and agents shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of Florida Statutes Section 768.28.

9. Effective Date. This MOU will become effective on the date of execution by final Agency Representative to sign.
