## RESOLUTION NO.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO RECAPTURE DOCUMENTARY SURTAX FUNDS FROM AGENCIES THAT DO NOT CLOSE FINANCING ON THE FUNDS WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF AWARD OR SIX MONTHS FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF RESOLUTION. WHICHEVER IS LATER: **FURTHER** AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO AWARD THOSE FUNDS THAT ARE RECAPTURED TO AGENCIES FOR NEXT IN LINE FEASIBLE PROJECTS FOR DOCUMENTARY SURTAX FUNDING

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County provides affordable housing activities throughout the County, which include Documentary Surtax; and

WHEREAS, the County's need is great but its resources are limited, making the efficient and expedient use of these Documentary Surtax funds imperative; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to ensure that persons and entities which receive Documentary Surtax funds are using these much-needed funds expeditiously in order to avoid waste; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to ensure that the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee recaptures these Documentary Surtax funds from Agencies that do not expeditiously close on the financing of these funds so that the funds may be used by Agencies better equipped to expeditiously use them and provide much needed housing,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board authorizes and directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to recapture Documentary Surtax

funds from Agencies that do not close financing on the funds within six months of award of the funds or six months from the effective date of this resolution, whichever is later. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is further authorized and directed to allocate the recaptured Documentary Surtax funds to Agencies for next in line feasible projects for Documentary Surtax funding. >>The recapture and allocation shall be subject to Board approval.<<\formsit The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is authorized to execute all letters of commitment, contracts, agreements and amendments, following approval by the County Attorney's Office, to effectuate the allocation of recaptured funds to the next in line feasible projects. >>County staff will review the next in line applicant's ability to proceed by confirming with their permitting agency, general contractor, and the other financing sources that they expect the applicant to be able to close within six months at terms equal to or better than the terms presented in the Surtax application. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall be authorized to grant extensions pursuant to the terms of resolution R-232-14.<<
