ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-2103 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA TO MODIFY THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MILITARY AFFAIRS BOARD ("MAB") AND PROVIDE FOR THE MAB'S ADDITION OF MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 2-2103(a) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:¹

Sec. 2-2103 Governing Board.

(a) *Composition and appointment.* The Military Affairs Board shall consist of ~~[[twenty-four (24)]]~~ voting members appointed as follows:

* * *

>>(12) The Reserve Officers' Training Corps program at the University of Miami, Florida International University, and Miami-Dade College shall each appoint one (1) representative to serve as a member of the Military Affairs Board.<<

The Military Affairs Board shall also consist of the following non-voting members:

* * *

When making a selection, each person or entity shall consider that the voting members should reflect the gender, racial>>_<< ethnic or cultural make-up of the community.

¹Words stricken through and/or ~~[[double bracketed]]~~ shall be deleted. Words underscored and/or >>double arrowed<< constitute the amendment proposed. Remaining provisions are now in effect and remain unchanged.

>>Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Military Affairs Board shall be permitted, by majority vote, to increase, through the addition of military-focused organizations, the membership of the Military Affairs Board without further amendment of this Ordinance. To the extent the Advisory Board creates new membership categories under this paragraph, the Advisory Board shall notify the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of the new membership category created. Appointments to any new membership categories created under this paragraph shall be approved by the Board of County Commissioners.<<

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
