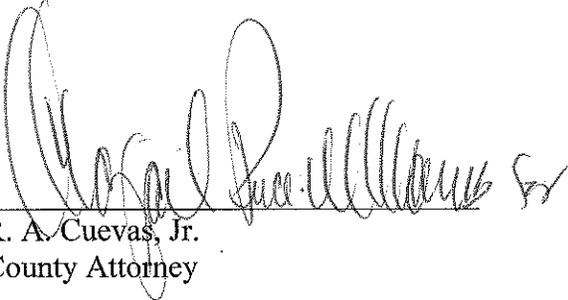

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-1432-02 AS AMENDED BY RESOLUTION NO. R-498-03 TO CHANGE THE EASTERN TERMINUS OF THE CODESIGNATION OF SW 120TH STREET AS "MONSIGNOR BRYAN O. WALSH STREET" FROM BEING SW 117TH AVENUE TO BEING SW 99TH COURT

**WHEREAS**, on December 17, 2002, this Board adopted Resolution No. R-1432-02, which codesignated SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 147<sup>th</sup> Avenue as "Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh Street," a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 6, 2003, this Board adopted Resolution No. R-498-03, which amended Resolution No. R-1432-02 to change the eastern terminus of the codesignation of SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street as "Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh Street" from being SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue to being SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue, a copy of which is also attached and incorporated by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh was a pillar of this community for over 40 years, and his legacy endures in the over 14,000 refugee children rescued from Cuban Communist oppression during the great Pedro Pan rescue mission of the early 1960s; and

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh directed the Catholic Welfare Bureau, which evolved into the Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Miami, and established nursing homes, home health services, and Catholic Hospice care from Broward to Monroe counties, providing health and social services to countless South Florida residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh Knights of Columbus Council #13369 was founded in his honor in 2003, two years after his passing, and is headquartered at Saint John Neumann Parish at the corner of SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street and SW 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, in honor of Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh's legacy and tireless commitment to this community, this Board would like to further amend Resolution No. R-1432-02 as amended by Resolution No. R-498-03 to change the eastern terminus of the codesignation of SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street as "Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh Street" from being SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to being SW 99<sup>th</sup> Court; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 99<sup>th</sup> Court is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 99<sup>th</sup> Court is briefly interrupted by State Road 874/Don Shula Expressway just east of SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the existing codesignation of SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 147<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue as "Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh Street" is located in County Commission Districts 8, 9 and 11; and

**WHEREAS**, the extension of this codesignation pursuant to this resolution is located in County Commission District 8,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, amends Resolution No. R-1432-02 as amended by Resolution No. R-498-03 to change the eastern terminus of the codesignation of SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street as "Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh Street" from being SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to being SW 99<sup>th</sup> Court.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the

Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 120<sup>TH</sup> STREET  
FROM SW 137<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE TO SW 147<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE AS  
MONSIGNOR BRYAN O. WALSH STREET

WHEREAS, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 147<sup>th</sup> Avenue as Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh Street; and

WHEREAS, Monsignor Walsh was born in Portarlington, Co. Offaly, Ireland, June 19, 1930; and

WHEREAS, from 1950-1954 Monsignor Walsh studied at St. Mary's University, Baltimore, Maryland, where he earned a Bachelor in Sacred Theology (1952) and a Licentiate in Sacred Theology (1954), and was ordained to the priesthood May 23, 1954 in St. Augustine Florida for the Diocese of St. Augustine; and

WHEREAS, after one year as an Assistant Pastor in Lakeland Florida, Monsignor Walsh was appointed Assistant Diocesan Director of Catholic Charities based in Miami; and

WHEREAS, Monsignor Walsh was named Archdiocesan Director of Catholic Charities and Executive Director of Catholic Community Services, formerly Catholic Welfare Bureau, serving in these positions until his retirement in 1996; and

WHEREAS, in the 1960's Monsignor Walsh organized and administered "Operation Pedro Pan," which brought over 14,000 unaccompanied Cuban refugee children from Cuba and provided foster care for them in the United States, many of whom today are leading citizens of Miami and hold high positions around the United States and abroad; and

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**WHEREAS**, in February 1965, the Catholic Charities was reorganized into two separate programs, "Catholic Welfare Bureau" and "Refugee and Economic Opportunity Programs." Monsignor Walsh was named Director of "Refugee and Economic Opportunity Programs" while serving as Pastor of SS. Peter and Paul Parish. From 1968 to 1973, he also served as the Episcopal Vicar for Spanish Speaking Peoples and Migrants; and

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Walsh was a distinguished member of the Board of Trustees of the Public Health Trust of Miami-Dade County, Florida, from 1973 to 1981, and served as Chairman of the Board between 1977 and 1979; and

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Walsh was the spokesperson and representative on social issues of the Archdiocese in the community on the local, national and international levels; and

**WHEREAS**, Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh passed away on December 20, 2001; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor the memory of Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh with this codesignation; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 11,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:**

Section 1. This Board waives the provisions of Resolution No. R-345-95, a copy of which is attached hereto, to the extent necessary for this codesignation and approves the codesignation of SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 147<sup>th</sup> Avenue as Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh Street.
