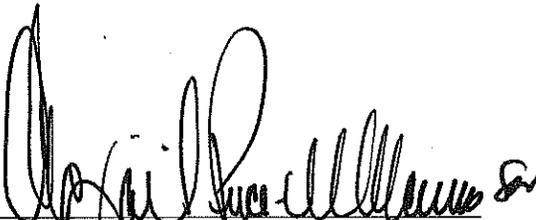

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE'S  
CODESIGNATION OF STATE ROAD 973/S.W. 87TH  
AVENUE BETWEEN S.W. 68TH STREET AND S.W. 70TH  
STREET AS "RENE LEDESMA WAY"

**WHEREAS**, during the 2014 regular session, the Florida Legislature passed Senate Bill 820, which among other codesignations, codesignated State Road 973/S.W. 87th Avenue between S.W. 68th Street and S.W. 70th Street as "Rene Ledesma Way"; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 820 is currently awaiting transmittal to the Governor for his approval;  
and

**WHEREAS**, Rene Ledesma is the owner of Rene's Barber Shop located at 7010 SW 87 Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Ledesma is retiring after 50 years of service to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the installation of state road designation signs shall be contingent on the applicable county or city commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary road designation; and

**WHEREAS**, State Road 973/S.W. 87th Avenue between S.W. 68th Street and S.W. 70th Street is a state road within unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, before the Florida Department of Transportation will install signs reflecting the "Rene Ledesma Way" road codesignation, Miami-Dade County is required to pass a resolution in support of this road designation; and

**WHEREAS**, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 7,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,** that this Board:

**Section 1.** Approves the Florida Legislature's codesignation of State Road 973/S.W. 87th Avenue between S.W. 68th Street and S.W. 70th Street as "Rene Ledesma Way".

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Zoning and Platting Division of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and the Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue Department.
