

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-934-99 TO TRANSFER THE NAMING OF THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT NORTHSIDE DISTRICT STATION AS THE "MAJOR ROSLYN McGRUDER CLARK NORTHSIDE STATION" TO THE NEW LOCATION OF THE NORTHSIDE DISTRICT STATION AT 799 NW 81ST STREET

WHEREAS, in February 1998, Major Roslyn McGruder Clark was assigned to the Northside District upon her appointment as Police Major and embarked on an ambitious plan to reduce district crime and improve the quality of life for area residents; and

WHEREAS, successful programs were implemented and enhanced under her command, including Weed and Seed, Grid 863, DUI/Gun Abatement and several enforcement initiatives; and

WHEREAS, Major Clark served the residents of the Northside District with great personal commitment and integrity, and was admired and respected by the district employees who continue the programs initiated under her command; and

WHEREAS, on July 31, 1999, Major Clark suffered an untimely death as a result of a ruptured cerebral aneurysm; and

WHEREAS, on September 9, 1999, this Board approved Resolution No. R-934-99, which named the Miami-Dade Police Department's Northside District located at 2950 N.W. 83 Street the "Major Roslyn McGruder Clark Northside District", a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, a new Northside District Station has been constructed at 799 NW 81st Street as part of the Arcola Lakes Complex, which also includes a library and a Head Start center; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to transfer the naming of the Northside District Station as the "Major Roslyn McGruder Clark Northside Station" to the new location of the Northside District Station at 799 NW 81st Street; and

WHEREAS, Rule 9.02 of the Board's Rules of Procedure provides that resolutions regarding proposed naming, renaming or codesignation of Miami-Dade County roads, facilities or property shall be sponsored by the district commissioner where the road, facility or property is located; and

WHEREAS, this proposed naming is located in County Commission District 2,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, amends Resolution No. R-934-99 to transfer the naming of the Miami-Dade Police Department Northside District Station as the "Major Roslyn McGruder Clark Northside Station" to the new location of the Northside District Station at 799 NW 81st Street.

Section 2. Directs the Mayor or designee to revise references to the new Northside District Station to the "Major Roslyn McGruder Clark Northside Station", and to install suitable signage to reflect the naming transfer.

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Miami-Dade Police Department and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached Resolution naming the Miami-Dade Police Department's Northside District located at 2950 N.W. 83 Street the Major Roslyn McGruder Clark Northside District in honor of Major Clark who passed away July 31, 1999.

BACKGROUND

On July 31, 1999, the Miami-Dade Police Department (MDPD) was deeply saddened by the untimely death of Major Roslyn McGruder Clark who suffered a ruptured cerebral aneurysm. During her distinguished law enforcement career, Major Clark achieved many outstanding accomplishments. In addition to being a role model, she was a dedicated Miami-Dade County employee.

In February 1998, upon her appointment as Police Major, she was assigned to the Northside District and embarked upon an ambitious plan to reduce district crime and improve the quality of life for area residents. Successful programs which were implemented and enhanced under her command include Weed and Seed, Grid 863, DUI/Gun Abatement and several enforcement initiatives. Major Clark served the citizens of the Northside District with great personal commitment and integrity. She was admired and respected by the district employees who continue the programs initiated under her command.

It is recommended that the Board approve the naming of the Northside District to permanently recognize Major Clark's many outstanding contributions to the MDPD and the citizens of Miami-Dade County. Although the district will continue to be referred to as the Northside District in order to maintain current operational activities, Major Clark's name will be prominently displayed on the facility in addition to a memorial plaque.
