RESOLUTION APPROVING THE STATE ROAD  
CODESIGNATION OF STATE ROAD 60/MIAMI  
GARDENS DRIVE BETWEEN N.E. 6TH AVENUE AND  
U.S. 1 AS "RONALD A. SILVER DRIVE"

**WHEREAS**, during the 2014 regular session, the Florida Legislature enacted Chapter 2014-228, Laws of Florida (Senate Bill 820), which among other codesignations, codesignated State Road 60/Miami Gardens Drive between N.E. 6th Avenue and U.S. 1 as "Ronald A. Silver Drive"; and

**WHEREAS**, Ronald A. Silver graduated from the University of Miami Law School in 1968; and

**WHEREAS**, he served in the Florida House of Representatives from 1978 until 1992; and

**WHEREAS**, he served as Chairman of the Miami-Dade County State Legislative Delegation in 1982-1983; and

**WHEREAS**, he served as House Majority Whip from 1984 to 1986; and

**WHEREAS**, he served as House Majority Leader from 1986 to 1988; and

**WHEREAS**, Silver was elected to the Florida Senate in 1992 to represent District 38 in Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, he served a second term as Chairman of the Miami-Dade County State Legislative Delegation in 1995-96; and

**WHEREAS**, he served in the Senate until 2002, when term limits prohibited him from running for reelection; and

**WHEREAS**, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the installation of state road designation signs shall be contingent on the applicable county or city commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary road designation; and

**WHEREAS**, State Road 60/Miami Gardens Drive between State Road 915/N.E. 6th Avenue and U.S. 1 is a state road located within the City of North Miami Beach and unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, before the Florida Department of Transportation will install signs reflecting the “Ronald A. Silver Drive” road codesignation, Miami-Dade County is required to pass a resolution in support of this road codesignation; and

**WHEREAS**, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 4,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Approves the state road codesignation of State Road 60/Miami Gardens Drive between N.E. 6th Avenue and U.S. 1 as “Ronald A. Silver Drive”.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the City Manager of the City of North Miami Beach, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Zoning and Platting Division of the Department of

Regulatory and Economic Resources, the Miami-Dade Police Department, the City of North Miami Beach Police Department and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Sally A. Heyman. It was offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
