RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 144 STREET
BETWEEN STATE ROAD 997/KROME AVENUE AND SW
179 AVENUE AS "SONIC'C' WAY"

WHEREAS, Anthony V. Rodriguez was born at Mercy Hospital in Miami on November 22, 1991; and

WHEREAS, by the age of 17, Anthony was an electronic dance music prodigy known as "SonicC" who had his first hit called Stickin'; and

WHEREAS, when he turned 18 years old, SonicC started traveling the world, first to California and later he was playing his music in places like Australia, Austria, London and throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, SonicC's music has been played on MTV's The Real World, Cinemax and FX; and

WHEREAS, his music also was in the video game Grand Theft Auto; and

WHEREAS, SonicC recorded with the Los Angeles music label Dim Mak Records; and

WHEREAS, SonicC was a rising star with a great future ahead of him; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2014, SonicC's life was tragically cut short in a head-on collision at SW 144 Street and State Road 997/Krome Avenue; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to recognize the memory of Anthony "SonicC" Rodriguez and his contributions to music by codesignating SW 144 Street between State Road 997/Krome Avenue and SW 179 Avenue as "SonicC Way"; and

WHEREAS, SW 144 Street between State Road 997/Krome Avenue and SW 179 Avenue is a County road located within unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Rule 9.02 of the Board's Rules of Procedure provides that resolutions regarding proposed codesignations of Miami-Dade County roads shall be sponsored by the district commissioner where the road is located; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 11,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 144 Street between State Road 997/Krome Avenue and SW 179 Avenue as "SonicC Way".

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Juan C. Zapata. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
