**Subject:** Resolution approving the Plat of AUTOZONE BIRD ROAD

## Recommendation

The following plat is hereby submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners for approval. This plat is bounded on the north by SW 39 Terrace, on the east by SW 65 Avenue, on the south by SW 40 Street (Bird Road), and on the west approximately 325 feet east of SW 67 Avenue. The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee, comprised of representatives from the Florida Department of Transportation, the Florida Department of Health, the Miami-Dade County School Board and Miami-Dade County Departments of Fire Rescue, Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces, Regulatory and Economic Resources (RER), Public Works and Waste Management (PWWM), and Water and Sewer, recommends approval and recording of this plat.

## Scope

This plat is located within the boundaries of Commission District 6, Chairwoman Rebeca Sosa.

## Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

If this plat is approved, the fiscal impact to the County would be approximately \$50.00 per year for the annual maintenance cost of that portion of SW 65 Avenue once the road is constructed adjacent to the project which will be funded through PWWM General Fund allocation.

## Track Record/Monitor

RER, Development Services Division administers the processing of plats and waivers of plat, and the person responsible for this function is Raul A. Pino, P. L. S.

- This plat meets concurrency


## Plat Restrictions

- That the Avenue, Terrace, and Streets, as illustrated on the plat, together with all existing and future planting, trees, shrubbery and fire hydrants thereon, are hereby dedicated to the perpetual use of the public for proper purposes, reserving to the dedicators, their successors and assigns the reversion or reversions thereof, whenever discontinued by law.

- That individual wells shall not be permitted within this subdivision, except for swimming pools, sprinkler systems and/or air conditioners.
- That the use of septic tanks will not be permitted within this subdivision, unless approved for temporary use, in accordance with County and State regulations.
- That all new electric and communication lines, except transmission lines, within this subdivision, shall be installed underground.

**Developer's Obligation**

- Mobilization, clearing, paving, milling, sidewalks, drainage, striping, detectable warning surfaces, landscaping and monumentation. Bonded under bond number 7908 in the amount of \$22,106.00.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAT OF AUTOZONE BIRD ROAD, LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 54 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY SW 39 TERRACE, ON THE EAST BY 65 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY SW 40 STREET (BIRD ROAD), AND ON THE WEST APPROXIMATELY 325 FEET EAST OF SW 67 AVENUE)

**WHEREAS**, Autozone Stores, Inc., a Nevada corporation, has this day presented to this Board a plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said plat to be known as AUTOZONE BIRD ROAD, the same being a replat of a portion of Lots 8 and 9, all of Lots 10 and 11, and a portion of Lots 12, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18, Block 42, of "Central Miami Part Two", according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 10, at Page 66, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, lying and being in the Southwest 1/4 of Section 13, Township 54 South, Range 40 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that said plat is hereby approved; that the dedication of the streets, alleys and other rights-of-way however designated or depicted on said plat is hereby accepted; that the Miami-Dade County Plat Restrictions as listed on said plat are approved and are to be enforced; that approval of the plat is not a waiver of any zoning regulations and that the requirements of the zoning existing on this land at the time this Resolution is approved shall be enforced whether or not the various parcels on this plat conform

to those requirements; this approval is conditioned upon the proper execution of all documents required by the County Attorney's Office.
