Resolution No. R-636-14, adopted on July 1, 2014, requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to complete background research on applicants being considered to serve on County Boards and Trusts that require nominations and/or appointments by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

In accordance with the Resolution, we are providing this report as a supplement to the BCC Agenda Item 15(D)1Substitute.

Pursuant to R-636-14, the OCA completed background research regarding BCC Agenda Item 15(D)1Substitute, Nominations for Appointment to the Children's Trust by the Governor, and there were no adverse findings for the following individuals: Lileana de Moya (Incumbent), Lawrence S. Forman, Jane J. Herron, Tiombe-Bisa Kendrick, Prakash S. Kumar, Julio E. Magrisso, Rev. RJ Starr, Jr., Lidia Vasseur Tuttle, and Eveline Pierre. The following information was found pursuant to the Miami-Dade County Clerk of Courts public records search and background research:
