Subject: Miami-Dade Transit Ridership Report (June 2014)

Attached is the Miami-Dade Transit Monthly Ridership Report across all modes for June 2014. The current fiscal reporting period spans nine months of ridership data since the new fare increases took effect on October 1, 2013.

For the reporting period of June 2014, overall system average daily ridership was lower compared to the June 2013 period, with a 4.1% decrease. This was generated by a 3.9% decrease in average weekday bus boardings, a decrease of 3.5% in Metrorail average weekday boardings, a decrease of 6.9% in Metromover average weekday boardings and a decrease of 3.2% in STS.

The largest increase in average weekday Metrorail boardings from June 2013 to June 2014 was registered at the following station:

The largest increases in average weekday Metrobus boardings from June 2013 to June 2014 were registered on the following routes:

Route 150 (Miami Airport Metrorail to South Dr. - South Beach)	40.9%	455
Route 88 (Dadeland North to 152 nd / 88th St. via Kendall Dr.)	17.0%	389
