

**Subject:** Miami-Dade Transit Ridership Report (July 2014)

Attached is the Miami-Dade Transit Monthly Ridership Report across all modes for July 2014. The current fiscal reporting period spans ten months of ridership data since the new fare increases took effect on October 1, 2013.


For the reporting period of July 2014, overall system average daily ridership was slightly lower compared to the July 2013 period, with a 0.9% decrease. This was generated by a 2.2% decrease in average weekday bus boardings, a 1.5% increase in Metrorail average weekday boardings, a 4.6% increase in Metromover average weekday boardings and a decrease of 1.5% in STS.

The largest increases in average weekday Metrorail boardings from July 2013 to July 2014 were registered at the following stations:

Metrorail Station Average Weekday Boardings	Percentage Increase	Boardings Increase
Brickell	8.6%	444
Douglas Road	9.4%	338
Dadeland North	3.7%	233

The largest increase in average weekday Metrobus boardings from July 2013 to July 2014 was registered on the following route:

Metrobus Route Average Weekday Boardings	Percentage Increase	Boardings Increase
Route 150 (Miami Airport Metrorail to South Dr. - South Beach)	35.0%	404
Route 88 (Dadeland North to 152 <sup>nd</sup> / 88th st via Kendall Drive)	14.9%	338
Route 120 (Downtown to Aventura via Collins Ave - Limited Stop)	3.5%	273
