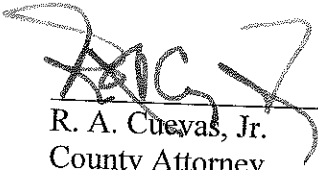

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO
INSTALL THE OFFICIAL MOTTO OF THE UNITED STATES
AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA, "IN GOD WE TRUST,"
BEHIND THE DAIS IN THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY
COMMISSION CHAMBERS

WHEREAS, the motto "In God We Trust" symbolizes the historical role of religion in our society, fosters patriotism, and expresses confidence in the future of our Nation, our State, and our County and its people; and

WHEREAS, this motto's role in our society is long-standing, as it has been used extensively over the years by the federal government; and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress ("the Congress") first authorized the National Mint to include "In God We Trust" on coins in 1865, made its inclusion mandatory on gold and silver coins in 1908, and mandated its appearance on all national coins and currency in 1955; and

WHEREAS, the Congress made "In God We Trust" the national motto in 1956, and the motto has been inscribed above the Speaker's rostrum in the United States House of Representatives, and also above the main door of the United States Senate Chamber; and

WHEREAS, "In God We Trust" was made the official motto of the State of Florida by the Florida Legislature in 2006; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to give recognition to the official motto of our Country and our State in the Miami-Dade County Commission Chambers,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the Mayor or designee to install, within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution, the official

motto of the United States and the State of Florida, "In God We Trust," behind the dais in the Miami-Dade County Commission Chambers, in substantially the same form as shown in Exhibit A to this resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz and the Co-Sponsors are Vice Chair Lynda Bell, Commissioner Esteban L. Bovo, Jr., Commissioner Audrey M. Edmonson, Chairwoman Rebeca Sosa, Senator Javier D. Souto and Commissioner Juan C. Zapata. It was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. 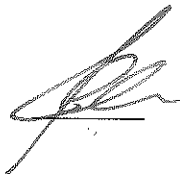
