**Subject:** Resolution Requesting Lease of State Right of Way of Collins Avenue in Haulover Park

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## Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) adopt the attached resolution requesting the lease of a 39,300 square foot area of State Road A-1-A right of way at Haulover Park (Exhibit A).

## Scope

Haulover Park is located at 10801 Collins Avenue in Commission District 4, which is represented by Commissioner Sally Heyman; however, Haulover Park is a countywide asset of regional significance.

## Fiscal Impact/Funding Source


Approval of this resolution will have no fiscal impact to Miami-Dade County.

## Track Record/Monitor

The Property Management Supervisor of the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS), John Bowers, will ensure completion of documents needed.

## Background

The right of way area of State Road A-1-A (Collins Avenue) under the bridge over Haulover Cut in Haulover Park is used by park users for parking and access. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has no records of any formal agreement for this use, which has been in effect since the bridge was first constructed and the road was moved from the east to its current location; therefore, FDOT would like to formalize the park use through a lease. In order to enter into a lease, the Board must first request the lease. Once this resolution is passed, PROS will apply for the lease. Once FDOT approves the application, PROS will prepare a resolution for the Board authorizing the County to enter into the lease.

RESOLUTION REQUESTING LEASE OF COLLINS AVENUE  
RIGHT OF WAY FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA FOR  
PUBLIC USE AT HAULOVER PARK

**WHEREAS**, the County, through its Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS), maintains Haulover Park, located at 10801 Collins Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida controls the right of way of Collins Avenue (State Road A-1-A) as it traverses Haulover Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the portion of right of way under the bridge over Haulover Cut (Exhibit A) is utilized by the public for parking and travel between the beachside and the bayside of the park; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida requires that the County first request a lease for this right of way area before applying for a lease of the area; and

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to apply for a lease with the State for this area; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board requests from the State of Florida a lease for the State-owned right of way area of Collins Avenue (State Road A-1-A) within Haulover Park.



**LEGAL DESCRIPTION**

**LEGAL DESCRIPTION**

A portion of land lying in the North  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 26, Township 52 South, Range 42 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the Survey Base line Station 24+29.27 according to the Florida Department of Transportation Right of Way Map, Section 87060, State Road No. A-1-A, Sheet 23 of 39, revision dated January 31 of 2008, State Road A-1-A and the Point of Commencement; said point being the Point of Curvature of a circular curve called C-21 on said Right of Way Map; thence South 03°35'24" East, along the said Survey Base line to the point of intersection with the South Line of Lot 4 of Tatum's Ocean Beach Park, according to the Plat thereof as recorded in Plat Book 5 at Page 35 of the Public Record of Miami-Dade County, Florida, for a distance of 68.68 feet to the Point of Beginning of the herein described parcel of land; thence North 86°52'55" East along said South Line of Lot 4 and to the point of intersection with the East Right of Way of State Road A-1-A, for a distance of 75.00 feet; thence South 03°35'24" East along said East Right of Way of State Road A-1-A and to the point of intersection with the south edge of the sea wall on the north side of the Haulover Bear Cut, for a distance of 262.99 feet; thence South 86°54'15" West along the south edge of the sea wall to the point of intersection of the West Right of Way of State Road A-1-A, for a distance of 150.01 feet; thence North 03°35'24" West along said West Right of Way of State Road A-1-A to the point of intersection with said South Line of Lot 4, for a distance of 262.93 feet; thence North 86°52'55" East along said South Line of Lot 4, for a distance of 75.00 feet the Point of Beginning, Lying and being in Miami-Dade County, Florida and containing 39,443.74 square feet more or less.



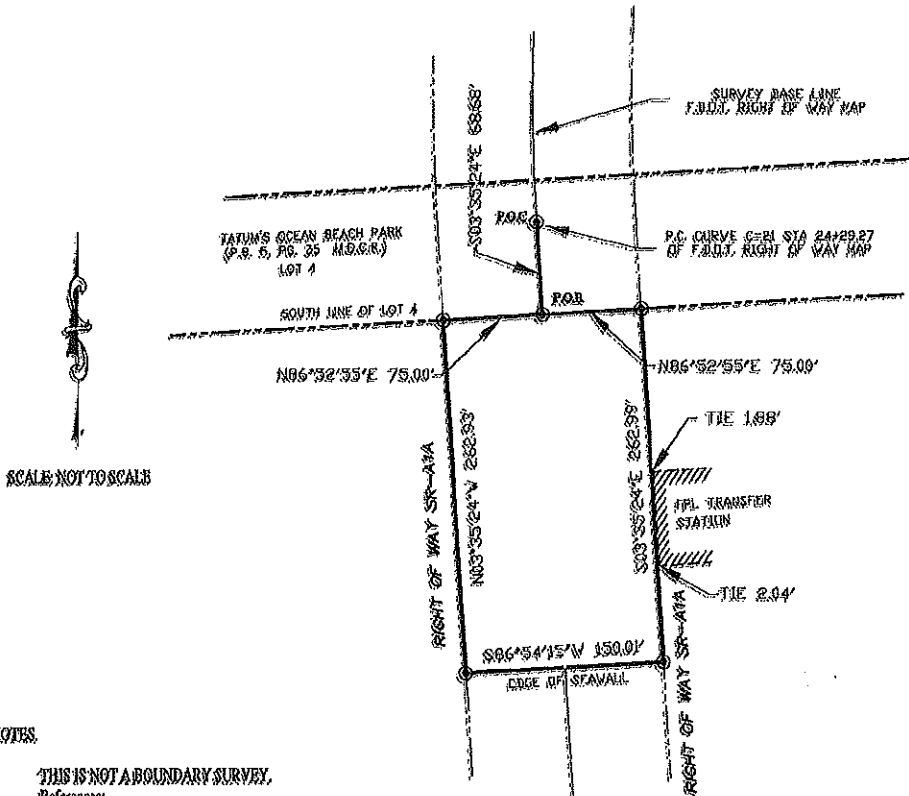
