PRESENT TERM LIMIT RESTRICTION FOR COUNTY BOARD MEMBERS; AND REAPPOINTING RICARDO GONZALEZ TO THE

FIRE PREVENTION AND SAFETY APPEALS BOARD

Resolution No. R-636-14, adopted on July 1, 2014, requires that the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) complete a background research on applicants being considered to serve on County Boards and Trusts that require nominations and/or appointments by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

In accordance with that Resolution, we are providing this report as a supplement to the BCC Agenda Item 11(A) 7.

Pursuant to R-636-14, the OCA completed a background research on Ricardo Gonzalez, who is being considered by the BCC for reappointment to the Fire Prevention and Safety Appeals Board, and there were no adverse findings.
