**Subject:** Contract Award Recommendation in the Amount of \$165,773.00 to Union Electrical Contractor, Inc. for the People's Transportation Plan Project Entitled Safe Routes to Schools Locations, Phase 9; and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds for Such Purposes

## Recommendation

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) project entitled *Safe Routes to Schools Locations, Phase 9, FM No. 431505-1* (Project MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08, Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) No. 20130219) in the amount of \$165,773.00 to Union Electrical Contractor, Inc., was prepared by the Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

This Contract Award Recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This Contract Award Recommendation may only be considered by the BCC if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the BCC prior to the date scheduled for BCC consideration or forty-five (45) days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and forty-five (45) days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

## Scope

The work to be performed under this Contract includes construction of safety related infrastructure improvements at the following Elementary Schools located in Miami-Dade County:

1. Avocado Elementary (16969 SW 294 Street, Homestead, Fl., District 8).
2. Redondo Elementary (18480 SW 304 Street, Homestead, Fl., District 8).
3. Dr. Robert B. Ingram Elementary (600 Ahmed Street, Opa-Locka, Fl., District 1).

## Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$165,773.00. The base contract amount is \$143,430.00, exclusive of contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. There is no fiscal impact to operations or maintenance.

This Project is being funded upfront by Charter County Transportation Sales Surtax Bond Sale Proceeds and is to be reimbursed by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) through Federal-aid highway funds allocated to the Safe Routes to Schools Program (SRTS). A Local Agency Program (LAP) Agreement between Miami-Dade County and FDOT was approved under BCC Resolution No. R-915-12. The LAP Agreement provides the County, with up to \$212,420.00 in SRTS funds to reimburse the County, for the design and construction of safety related infrastructure improvements at three (3) schools located in Miami-Dade County.

The fiscal impact of this contract award will be approximately \$165,773.00. The base contract amount is \$143,430.00, with the total amount being inclusive of contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. There is no fiscal impact to operations or maintenance. The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. The funding index code for this project is CPE333CPPW30.

**Delegation of Authority**

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this Contract.

**Track Record/Monitor**

Union Electrical Contractor, Inc. is currently performing work for PWWM at a satisfactory level. PWWM has reviewed the Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) database and found 25 awarded construction contracts as follows:

- three (3) from Aviation,
- three (3) from Housing,
- 13 from Internal Services,
- two (2) from Transit,
- one (1) from Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces,
- one (1) from the Water and Sewer Department, and
- two (2) from PWWM.

The referenced database also lists a total of four (4) contractor performance evaluations with an overall performance rating of 3.0 (satisfactory performance), out of a possible 4.0 (superior performance) rating. The Small Business Development Division (SBD) History of Violation's report lists no violations for this contractor. According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, Union Electrical Contractor, Inc., Company Principals are Jose D. Ruiz and Genesis Hassan and the Company's address is listed as 2825 SW 79 Court, Miami, Florida 33155.

Following PWWM's standard operating procedures, after award of this Contract a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. The person responsible for all PTP projects in PWWM is Mr. Alejandro Martinez-Estevé, RA, LEED AP, Manager, Capital Improvements Section. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Oscar Rubio, Project Manager, for day-to-day responsibilities.

**Background**

As part of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWWM continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms such as the Miscellaneous Construction Contracting process available under the MCC 7360 Program.

Through this process, PWWM forwards a Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) by way of facsimile transmission to a pool of firms that have registered with the Internal Services Department for the respective trade. Additionally, PWWM advertises the project in the *Daily Business Review* and all solicitations are available on-line through the Miami-Dade County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The project's award evaluation is based upon the bid submitted by the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWWM submitted its contract measure recommendation for Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) participation for this RPQ to SBD. SBD completed its Project Review and Analysis and established an 8.60 percent DBE participation goal. A Community Workforce Program Goal was deemed not applicable to this RPQ.

On April 17, 2014, PWWM forwarded RPQ No. 20130219, utilizing the MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08 Contract, to a list of 140 pre-qualified firms. A total of five (5) firms purchased contract documents and four (4) firms proffered a bid.

On May 28, 2014, Union Electrical Contractor, Inc. proffered the lowest responsive and responsible base bid of \$143,430.00, seven (7) percent below the County's cost estimate. The second lowest bidder, Statewide Electrical Services, Inc., proffered a base bid of \$143,996.00, seven (7) percent below the County's cost estimate. The third lowest bidder, Wrangler Construction, Inc., proffered a base bid of \$148,461.72, four (4) percent below the County's cost estimate. Based on the results of the solicitation, PWWM issued a recommendation for award on August 22, 2014 for RPQ No. 20130219 to Union Electrical Contractor, Inc., with the stipulation that approval for this project must be obtained from the CITT and the Board.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, equipment, and tools to perform all operations necessary to add/upgrade pedestrian indication heads and push buttons at signalized intersections, install school speed zone signs and flashing beacons, school crosswalk signs, pavement markings, sidewalks, and pedestrian ramps.

The purpose of this Project is to enable and encourage students in Kindergarten through eighth grade to walk and/or bicycle to and from school; to make walking and bicycling to school safer and more appealing; and to facilitate the planning, development, and implementation of projects that will improve safety and reduce traffic, fuel consumption, and air pollution in the vicinity of schools. To date, 65 schools have been identified as part of the Program, with improvements completed at 32 of those schools.

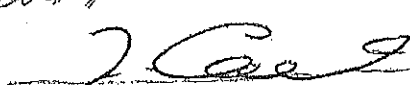

This letter will serve as your notification that you have been recommended for award for the above referenced RPQ based on your Price Quotation submitted on Wednesday, May 28, 2014. The total RPQ amount is for one hundred sixty-five thousand seven hundred seventy-three dollars and zero cents (\$165,773.00). This includes a base contract amount of one hundred forty-three thousand four hundred thirty dollars and zero cents (\$143,430.00), a contingency amount of fourteen thousand three hundred forty-three dollars and zero cents (\$14,343.00), and dedicated allowances totaling eight thousand dollars and zero cents (\$8,000.00). The contract duration is established as **272-calendar days**. However, the recommendation of award is contingent upon the submission of the required items listed below:

1. Performance and Payment Bond as required in Contract No. MCC 7360 Plan, Section 2.0 Special Conditions, Page 16, Article 2.11, **PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND**. (The **original attached documents** must be used and three (3) sets must be provided).
2. Letter from Bonding Agent granting Miami-Dade County authorization to date the Performance Bond.
3. Copies of current insurance certificates.
4. Copies of required license(s).

The preceding documents are required as outlined within the Contract MCC 7360 Plan and to be submitted within 10 business days. Failure to submit the document(s) within the specified time, or any extension granted, will result in the award being rescinded.

Subsequent to the review and approval of the aforementioned documents, you are required to obtain the required permits in the time stipulated in the RPQ. Upon obtaining the permit(s), a copy(s) must be submitted to the Project Manager prior to commencement of work. No work is to be performed without a permit unless the Project Manager issues a written directive to proceed without permit(s).

This letter will also serve as a reminder that all work must be performed according to the scope of work and contract's terms and conditions, all permits and inspections and in accordance with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, codes and regulations.

Additionally, please be advised that your firm must have the resources to ensure work proceeds without delay once the "Notice to Proceed" is issued. Lack of equipment, personnel or additional contracts with similar completion schedules, will not be reason for delay.

Further, it shall be understood that since proceeds from the Charter County Transportation System Sales Surtax levied pursuant to Section 29.121 of the Code of Miami-Dade County may be used to pay for all or some part of the cost of this contract, no award of this contract shall be effective and thereby give rise to a contractual relationship with the County unless and until the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) and the County Commission have approved the award of the contract, and such award becomes final (either by expiration of 10 days after such award without veto by the Mayor, or by Commission override of a veto).

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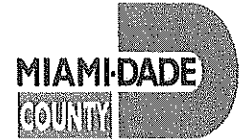
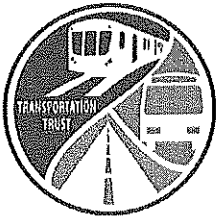
