RESOLUTION NO.

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO DEVELOP A PLAN TO IMPLEMENT A WARNING SYSTEM TO PREVENT HIGH VEHICLES FROM COLLIDING WITH THE CONCRETE OVERPASS AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE ARRIVALS AREA AT MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

WHEREAS, there have been several serious accidents at Miami International Airport ("Airport") as a result of high vehicles colliding into the concrete overpass entrance to the arrivals area of the Airport, including a bus crash which caused two fatalities and critical injuries on December 2, 2013; and

WHEREAS, vehicles that are too tall to clear the 8-foot-6-inch concrete overpass into the arrivals area are directed by signage to go through the departures area because of its higher clearance; and

WHEREAS, the posted signage also warns drivers not to pass beneath the concrete overpass if their vehicle does not meet the height requirement for clearance; and

WHEREAS, the posted signage has not proven to be effective in preventing collisions into the overpass; and

WHEREAS, implementation of a warning system on the approach to and/or at the concrete overpass to the arrivals area of the Airport is a safety measure that will significantly reduce the potential risk of injury to the traveling public and the economic impact resulting from damage to the Airport structure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Directs the County Mayor or designee to develop a plan to implement a warning system to prevent high vehicles from colliding with the concrete overpass entrance into the arrivals area of Miami International Airport, which shall include the costs associated with implementing such a plan.

Section 2. The County Mayor or designee shall present such plan to this Board in a report within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution and shall place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dennis C. Moss. It was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
