### **Course Description**

*Cyclists will follow the lead MDPD police vehicle on the inside inbound travel lane, turning at the Calusa Park circle (just past the fire station), traveling westerly (outbound towards the mainland) in the center inside lane to the Crandon Park Marina entrance. At this point cyclists will turn and complete a 2nd loop, returning to the point of origin.*

## Hundreds of Miami Cyclists take to the streets to raise awareness as local cycling deaths hit close to home

As part of worldwide event occurring simultaneously around the world.

Miami Florida 2014: On Wednesday May 21<sup>st</sup> at 7:00pm,

hundreds of local cyclists will take part in a silent slow-paced ride (max. 12 mph) in honor of those who have been injured or killed while cycling on public roadways. The 2014 Miami Ride of Silence will depart from Crandon Park Marina parking lot, 4000 Crandon Blvd., Key Biscayne, FL 33149

To HONOR those who have been injured or killed  
To RAISE AWARENESS that we are here  
To ask that we all **SHARE THE ROAD**

**Facts:** In 2011, 677 cyclists were killed and 48,000 injured in the US. This is 9% higher than the previous year. Florida once again leads the US in bicycling fatalities in 2011. 125 cyclists lost their lives on Florida Roadways; this accounts for 18.5% of all traffic related fatalities in the US. Sadly, bicyclists and pedestrians account for 5.2% of all traffic fatalities in Florida. Sadly, in the most recent statistics, Florida is the leader, 1<sup>st</sup> place in amount of cyclists killed in public roadways.

This ride serves to educate motorists that cyclists have the legal right to the road and to watch out for cyclists. Bicycle-motorist accidents in Miami-Dade County illustrate the need to remind motorists of the 2006 law that requires motorists to leave a 3 foot space when overtaking a bicycle. The Ride Of Silence is a safe, silent way of reminding them of this need. The Ride, which has been locally supported by Everglades Bicycle Club in Miami, KBPD, MDPD, PWWM and local commissioners, since 2005, hopes to raise awareness during National Bike Safety Month to motorists, police, city officials and cyclist alike. The ROS is also a chance to mourn, in funeral procession style, those who have already been killed. The ride also requests black armbands be worn, red if you have had a bike/motor vehicle accident.

South Florida has recently mourned too many victims; from a High School Senior who was a son, brother, cousin and friend to husbands and fathers from South Miami who have left small children and wives behind....Christophe LeCanne and Aaron Cohen (whose white ghost bike is placed by the BearCut Bridge, on the Rickenbacker Causeway on Key Biscayne). AND This year thanks to Comm. Xavier L. Suarez's support the ride will go on.

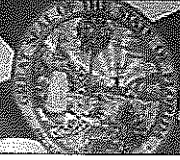
The Ride of Silence is similar to a funeral procession. There will be no talking, only silence, to remember our fallen brothers and sisters. Black armbands are worn in memory of those who have been killed; red armbands are worn for those injured while riding.

Originally started in May 2003, in Texas by Chris Phelan in Dallas after his friend endurance cyclist Larry Schwartz was hit by the mirror of a passing bus and was killed, it was suppose to be a one time event, but as word got out about the ride, many cyclists contacted Chris with the desire to participate in this event. Hundreds of rides in Antarctica, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Caribbean, Chile, Cyprus, Hong Kong, Japan, México, New Zealand, and Singapore will all begin precisely at 7pm on Wednesday.

This ride is NOT a fundraiser. There is no fee. All we want is for cyclists of all ages and abilities to ride with us. This year we will maintain the 12 miles per hour and ride for less than 8 short miles. Victims, friends and family members of those killed and various political figures will be available to the press to discuss (either in Spanish or English) their personal accident experiences and their stance on these occurrences.




