ORDINANCE RELATING TO RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; AMENDING SECTION 2-1 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, REGARDING PREPARATION OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS; ESTABLISHING A TIMEFRAME WITHIN WHICH A PRIME SPONSOR MUST REQUEST PLACEMENT OF AN ITEM ON AN AGENDA; PROHIBITING ANOTHER COUNTY COMMISSIONER FROM REQUESTING THAT THE SAME OR SIMILAR ITEM BE PLACED ON THE SUCH TIMEFRAME; ALLOWING AGENDA DURING ANOTHER COUNTY COMMISSIONER TO REQUEST THAT THE SAME OR SIMILAR ITEM BE PLACED ON THE AGENDA AFTER THE EXPIRATION OF SUCH TIMEFRAME: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 2-1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:¹

Sec. 2-1. Rules of procedure of County Commission.

PART 5. CONDUCT OF MEETINGS; AGENDA

Rule 5.06 Ordinances, resolutions, motions, contracts.

(a) Preparation and enactment of ordinances. The County Attorney, when requested, shall prepare ordinances and resolutions. >> Whenever a Commissioner requests that the

Words stricken through and/or [[double bracketed]] shall be deleted. Words underscored and/or >>double arrowed<< constitute the amendment proposed. Remaining provisions are now in effect and remain unchanged.

County Attorney prepare an ordinance or resolution, the prime sponsor shall have six months from the date of the request for legislation within which to submit the item to the Chairperson of the County Commission for placement on the appropriate agenda. Prior to submission by the prime sponsor of the item to the Chairperson of the County Commission for placement on the appropriate agenda, no other Commissioner may request that the same or substantially similar item be placed on the agenda. If a requested item is not submitted by the prime sponsor to the Chairperson of the County Commission for placement on the agenda within six months from the date of the request for the legislation, any other Commissioner may request that the same or substantially similar item be prepared for placement on the agenda.

Ordinances may be introduced and listed by title and shall be read by title only before consideration by the Commission on first reading. On first reading of ordinances, there shall be no discussion by either County Commissioners, County staff or members of the public, except as provided in Rule 6.06. On first reading only, the Commission may either vote for all ordinances in one (1) vote or may vote separately on any ordinance. At second reading, each ordinance shall be voted on individually.

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

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Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
