Subject: Contract Award Recommendation in the Amount of \$7,190,569.64 to JVA Engineering Contractors, Inc. for the People's Transportation Plan Project Entitled Roadway Improvements along NW 74 Street, from NW 87 Avenue to State Road 826/Palmetto Expressway, Located within Commission District 12; and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds

Recommendation

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) project entitled Roadway Improvements along NW 74 Street, from NW 87 Avenue to State Road 826/Palmetto Expressway (Project No. 20130202 PTP, FM No. 414731-5; Contract No. 20130202) in the amount of \$7,190,569.64 to JVA Engineering Contractor, Inc., was prepared by the Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

This Contract Award Recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). This Contract Award Recommendation may only be considered by the BCC if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the BCC prior to the date scheduled for BCC consideration or forty-five (45) days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and forty-five (45) days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

Delegation of Authority

The authority of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute and implement this contract is consistent with those authorities granted under the Code of Miami-Dade County. No additional authority is being requested within the body of this Contract.

Scope

PROJECT NAME: PTP Roadway Improvements along NW 74 Street, from NW 87 Avenue to State Road 826/Palmetto Expressway (SR-826), FM No. 414731-5

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The work to be performed under this Contract consists of, but is not limited to furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, tools, equipment and performing all operations necessary for roadway improvements along NW

74 Street, from NW 87 Avenue to SR-826.

The improvements include widening the existing road from a five-lane undivided roadway to a six-lane divided roadway with turn lanes, bike lanes, raised medians, sidewalks, curb and gutters, a continuous storm drainage system, pavement markings and signage, traffic signalization, roadway lighting, landscaping, and irrigation. Night work will be required at several intersections.

The project also includes removal of approximately 6,751 cubic yards of solid waste from the southeast corner of NW 74 Street and NW 87 Avenue, and the NW 74 Street and NW 84 Avenue intersection, and disposing of the excavated solid waste at a Class 1 Landfill.

Work also includes various construction activities within the remediation areas depicted on the plans such as, clearing and grubbing, furnishing and installing drainage structures and lateral lines between drainage structures, and back-filling/compacting excavated areas. This contamination assessment and remediation work is to be performed by a Contamination Assessment and Remediation Contractor who will be coordinating his work with the Prime Roadway Contractor.

The fiscal impact will be \$7,190,569.64. The base contract amount is \$6,449,154.22, with the total amount being inclusive of contingency and dedicated allowance amounts.

This Project is being funded by Charter County Transportation Sales Surtax Bond Sale Proceeds, and is to be fully reimbursed by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). A Local Agency Program (LAP) Agreement between Miami-Dade County and FDOT was approved on November 5, 2013, under BCC Resolution No. R-873-13. The aforementioned Agreement provides the County, with up to \$6,572,521.00 in funds.

Subsequent to this Agreement, and in order to account for the additional monies required to cover the project's total costs, the County and FDOT agreed to an increase in project funding through the execution of a Local Agency Program Supplemental Agreement. Said Supplemental Agreement was approved by the BCC on December 2, 2014, through Resolution No. 1029-14.

This site-specific project is listed in Exhibit 1 of the PTP Ordinance as a Board Requested Major Roadway and Neighborhood Improvement Project within Commission District 12. Any other applicable funding source may subsidize the Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds allocated to this Contract.

EXPLANATION: This project was advertised on April 10, 2014, and on May 14, 2014, six (6) engineering contractor firms proffered bids for the referenced project, and the three (3) lowest responsive and responsible bids were as follows: the lowest bidder, JVA Engineering Contractors, Inc., proffered a base bid of \$6,449,154.22, 19 percent above the County's cost estimate; the second lowest bidder, Metro Express, Inc., proffered a base bid of \$6,820,756.33,

25 percent above the County's cost estimate; and the third lowest bidder, Maytin Engineering Corp., proffered a base bid of \$7,293,268.90, 34 percent above the County's cost estimate.

The difference between the Engineer's estimate and the lowest bid was a result of the time period between when the estimate was provided to FDOT as part of the LAP Agreement approval and the eventual receipt of bids.

JVA Engineering Contractors, Inc. is currently performing work for PWWM at a satisfactory level. PWWM has reviewed the Capital Improvements Information System (CIIS) database and found 35 awarded construction contracts from each of the following departments:

- one (1) from Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces,
- nine (9) from Seaport,
- 20 from Water and Sewer, and
- five (5) from PWWM.

The referenced database also lists a total of 23 contractor performance evaluations with an overall performance rating of 3.4 (satisfactory performance).

As such, PWWM recommends that JVA Engineering Contractors, Inc., the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, be awarded the subject Contract for the sum of \$7,190,569.64.

Following PWWM's standard operating procedures, after award of this contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. The person responsible for all PTP projects in PWWM is Mr. Alejandro Martinez-Esteve, RA, LEED AP, Manager, Capital Improvements section. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Rakeshpal Gill, Project Manager, for day to day responsibilities.

This project is federally funded and is guided under 49 C.F.R. 26.13, where local agencies are required to have a signed policy statement expressing their commitment to DBE participation. As per Local Agency Program Manual, 14.2.2 Overall DBE Goal, FDOT is required to set overall DBE goals every three (3) years. The overall FDOT DBE goal for Federal Fiscal Years (FFY) 2015-2017 is 9.91%, effective October 1, 2014. (The goal for fiscal years 2012-2014 was 8.60%.) FDOT aspires to spend 9.91% of FHWA funds on projects with Certified DBEs as prime contractors/subcontractors and prime consultants/subconsultants. BACKGROUND:

Rapid population growth in the northwest area of Miami-Dade County, and the increased traffic demand associated with the residential and industrial land uses along the project area, have had an impact on the limited capacity of the roadway network. The existing five-lane undivided segment east of NW 87 Avenue is currently serving a limited industrial area near the Palmetto Expressway (SR-826). This approximate one (1) mile segment of roadway does not have the capacity to handle projected traffic volumes for the area.

FDOT performed a Project Development and Environmental Study for evaluation of the existing portions of NW 74 Street, from NW 114 Ave to SR-826/Palmetto Expressway. The analysis determined that a six-lane typical section was required to meet the expected future travel demand of the corridor.

The NW 74 Street corridor was divided into three (3) segments. The first segment, NW 107 Avenue to NW 87 Avenue, has been constructed. The second segment, NW 114 Avenue to NW 107 Avenue, is currently in the contract award process. This project is the third of the three (3) segments that will improve NW 74 Street between NW 87 Avenue and SR-826. Once construction of all segments is complete, NW 87 Avenue and SR-826 will be transferred to FDOT, and will become State Road/SR-934.
