Recommendation for Approval to Establish a Pre-Qualification Pool:

Concession Services and Related Activities

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve establishment of a prequalification pool, *Contract No. RTQ-00109*, to purchase concession services and related activities, as needed for the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS). The services and activities to be provided include, but are not limited to, sports, fitness, arts, mobile vending carts, concession stands, environmental activities and the operation of recreational facilities.

The pre-qualified vendors shall be invited to participate in future spot market competitions. The awarded bidder shall perform the solicited services at a park or facility operated by PROS. All services will be offered to the public for a fee, which will generate revenue to the County.

## Scope

The impact of this item is countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

This estimated revenue to the County is \$2,400,000 for the eight-year term. The contract amount is based on PROS' projected revenue from the anticipated services and activities.

**Delegated Authority** 

Upon approval of this item, a pool of pre-qualified vendors will be established to participate in spot market competitions. The County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee will have the authority to solicit pricing and award contracts up to an aggregate contract amount of the allocation authorized by the Board. Additionally, the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee may add qualified vendors to the pool at any time during the contract term, subject to bi-annual ratification by the Board. The County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee will also have the authority to exercise, at their discretion, any cancellation and renewal provisions in accordance with the terms and conditions of the pool contract.

Vendor(s) Pre-Qualified for Pool:

A Request to Qualify (RTQ) was issued under full and open competition on August 1, 2014. The method of award was to pre-qualify all responsive and responsible vendors that met the minimum requirements as specified in the RTQ for participation in future spot market competitions. Additional qualified vendors may be added to the pool at any time during the contract term. The vendors listed in the table below met the pre-qualification criteria.

RESOLUTION APPROVING ESTABLISHMENT OF PREQUALIFICATION POOL NO. RTQ-00109 TO CONTRACT FOR CONCESSION SERVICES AND RELATED ACTIVITIES WITH A PROJECTED REVENUE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,400,000.00 FOR THE MIAMI-DADE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO AWARD SUBSEQUENT CONTRACTS AND EXERCISE ANY CANCELLATION PROVISIONS CONTAINED THEREIN

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves establishment of prequalification pool RTQ-00109 to contract for Concession Service and Related Activities as set forth in the incorporated memorandum with a projected revenue in the amount of \$2,400,000.00 for the Miami-Dade Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department.

Section 2. Authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to conduct spot bids, award subsequent contracts, and exercise any cancellation provisions contained therein, and to add vendors to the pool at any time, subject to ratification by the Board on a bi-annual basis.
