RESOLUTION WAIVING, BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF MEMBERS PRESENT, THE TERM LIMIT FOR MIAMI-DADE COUNTY HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD MEMBER DR. PAUL S. GEORGE; AND REAPPOINTING DR. PAUL S. GEORGE TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD FOR ANOTHER TERM

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County (the "Code"), no board member may serve more than eight consecutive years on a board unless the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board"), by a two-thirds vote of the members present, votes to waive the eight-year term limit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 16A-6 of the Code, the term of office for members of the Miami-Dade County Historic Preservation Board (the "Historic Preservation Board") is four years; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Paul S. George is a professor of history at Miami-Dade College and a historian at HistoryMiami; and

WHEREAS, Dr. George is presently a member of the Historic Preservation Board; and WHEREAS, Dr. George has served as a member of the Historic Preservation Board for more than eight years; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to waive the applicable term limit and reappoint Dr. George to another term on the Historic Preservation Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board, by two-thirds vote of the members present, waives the restriction that a particular member of a board

may not serve more than eight consecutive years on that board, and reappoints Dr. Paul S. to another four-year term as a member of the Historic Preservation Board.
