RESOLUTION DIRECTING COUNTY MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO REVIEW SECTION 2-8.2.7.01 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND IMPLEMENTING ORDER 3-53 RELATING TO MISCELLANEOUS CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS PROGRAM ("MCC PROGRAM") AND TO SUBMIT PROPOSED AMENDMENTS FOR SEPARATE ADMINISTRATION OF THE MCC PROGRAM'S 7040 PLAN FOR CONSTRUCTION WORK RELATING TO THE COUNTY'S WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the water and sewer infrastructure throughout Miami-Dade County is deteriorating and in need of repair, replacement and restoration in order to continue to provide the citizens of Miami-Dade County with reliable water and sewer service and comply with federal, state and local regulatory laws including the recently approved Clean Water Act federal Consent Decree ("Consent Decree"); and

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department is embarking on a multi-billion dollar capital improvement program to improve the water and sewer system which includes \$1.6 billion of improvements to comply with the Consent Decree; and

WHEREAS, this Board recently provided authority to the County administration to expedite the processing, procurement and award of contracts for goods and services, construction and professional services for the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, this Board created the Miscellaneous Construction Contracts Program ("MCC Program") in order to enhance the contracting opportunities of Small Business Enterprises (SBE) - Construction and to facilitate and expedite the award of construction contracts to small businesses; and

WHEREAS, the MCC Program is codified in Section 2-8.2.7.01 of the Code of Miami-Dade County and administered through Implementing Order 3-53; and

WHEREAS, the MCC 7040 Plan is a one hundred percent (100%) set-aside for SBE - Construction; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to further increase opportunities for SBE - Construction that are qualified to perform work on the County's water and sewer system and to expedite the award of contracts to such small businesses under the County's MCC program by separate administration of the 7040 Plan for construction work relating to the County's water and sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the Small Business Development Division of the Internal Services Department currently administers the overall MCC Program including the 7040 Plan,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to:

Section 1. Review Section 2-8.2.7.01 of the Code of Miami-Dade County and Implementing Order 3-53 relating to the County's MCC Program and submit proposed amendments for separate administration of the MCC Program by a department such as the Internal Services Department - Small Business Development Division for construction work relating to the County's water and sewer system. Such amendments shall be provided to this Board within 60 days of the effective date of this Resolution and should include one tier for projects valued at \$2 million and less and a second tier for projects valued greater than \$2 million but less than \$5 million.

Section 2. Provide this Board commencing within ninety days of Board approval of amendments to the MCC Program, a quarterly report that includes the number of awards, total dollars awarded and SBE - Construction activity under the MCC Program's 7040 Plan for construction work relating to the County's water and sewer system for the previous quarter. Each report shall be placed on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan and the Co-Sponsor is Commissioner Audrey M. Edmonson. It was offered by
