RESOLUTION WAIVING BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE
OF MEMBERS PRESENT TERM LIMIT
RESTRICTIONS FOR ART-IN-PUBLIC PLACES
TRUSTEE SANDI-JO GORDON; AND REAPPOINTING
HER TO THE ART-IN-PUBLIC-PLACES TRUST

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners enacted Ordinance No. 10-06, amending Chapter 2, Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida to permit the waiver of term limits for members of County boards; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code, no board member shall serve more than eight consecutive years on a board unless the Board of County Commissioners, by a two-thirds vote of the members present, votes to waive the eight year term limit; and

WHEREAS, according to Section 2-11.15(2)(a)(1) of the Code, Trustees of the Art-in-Public-Places Trust are appointed to a term which ends concurrently with the last day of the term of the County Commissioner who appointed that member; and

WHEREAS, in addition, Section 2-11.15(2)(a)(2) provides that no Trustee shall serve more than eight consecutive years on the Trust; and

WHEREAS, Sandi-Jo Gordon has been appointed to the Trust as the representative of the District 4 Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to waive the applicable term limits and reappoint Sandi-Jo Gordon to the Trust, as the representative of the District 4 Commissioner for another term; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Sandi-Jo Gordon's resumé is attached,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board, by a two-thirds vote of the members present, waives the restrictions that a particular member of a board may not serve more than eight consecutive years on that board, and reappoints Sandi-Jo Gordon to an additional term as a Trustee of the Art-in-Public-Places Trust.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Sally A. Heyman. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
