RESOLUTION WAIVING BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT TERM LIMIT RESTRICTIONS FOR PARKS AND RECREATION CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBER KAREN EVANS; REAPPOINTING KAREN EVANS TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR ANOTHER TERM

WHEREAS, Ms. Karen Evans is a respected attorney and mediator in the Miami-Dade County community; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Evans has served on the Executive Board of the Parks Foundation of Miami-Dade and has been a long-time member of the Parks and Recreation Citizens Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Evans is presently a member of the Parks and Recreation Citizens Advisory Committee and has reached her term limit as a member of such Committee; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, which governs the Parks and Recreation Citizens Advisory Committee with respect to term limits, states that no board member shall serve more than eight consecutive years on any one board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-11.38.2(b) of the Miami-Dade County Code, the Board of County Commissioners may, by resolution adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of members present, waive a term limit applicable to a member of a County board; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to waive the applicable term limit and reappoint Ms. Evans to another term on the Parks and Recreation Citizens Advisory Committee,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that, by a two-thirds vote of the Board members present and pursuant to Section 2-11.38.2(b) of the Miami-Dade County Code, this Board waives the term limit restrictions applicable to Parks and Recreation Citizens Advisory Committee member Ms. Karen Evans, and reappoints Ms. Karen Evans to another term as a member of the Parks and Recreation Citizens Advisory Committee.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Sally A. Heyman. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
