RESOLUTION WAIVING BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT TERM LIMIT RESTRICTIONS FOR FILM AND ENTERTAINMENT ADVISORY BOARD MEMBER SHEILA DUFFY-LEHRMAN; REAPPOINTING SHEILA DUFFY-LEHRMAN TO THE FILM AND ENTERTAINMENT ADVISORY BOARD FOR ANOTHER TERM

WHEREAS, Sheila Duffy-Lehrman is a respected creative professional and leader in the Miami-Dade County community; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Duffy-Lehrman has served as a long-time member of the Film and Entertainment Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Duffy-Lehrman is presently a member of the Film and Entertainment Advisory Board and has reached her term limit as a member of such Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, which governs the Film and Entertainment Advisory Board with respect to term limits, states that no board member shall serve more than eight consecutive years on any one board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-11.38.2(b) of the Miami-Dade County Code, the Board of County Commissioners may, by resolution adopted by a two-thirds vote of members present, waive a term limit applicable to a member of a County board; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to waive the applicable term limit and reappoint Ms.

Duffy-Lehrman to another term on the Film and Entertainment Advisory Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that, by a two-thirds vote of the Board members present and pursuant to Section 2-11.38.2(b) of the Miami-Dade County Code, this Board waives the term limit restrictions applicable to Film and Entertainment Advisory Board member Sheila Duffy-Lehrman, and reappoints Ms. Duffy-Lehrman to another term as a member of the Film and Entertainment Advisory Board.
