RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI
CODESIGNATION OF SW 12TH STREET FROM SW 12TH
AVENUE TO SW 14TH AVENUE AS "ERNESTO DIAZ
MADRUGA WAY"

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2014, the Miami City Commission adopted Resolution No. R-14-0452, which codesignated SW 12th Street from SW 12th Avenue to SW 14th Avenue as "Ernesto Diaz Madruga Way," in recognition of his courage in opposing the communist regime of Cuba, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, at the age of 22, Ernesto Diaz Madruga worked at the Central Corazon de Jesus in Cuba; and

WHEREAS, Ernesto was a member of the Directorio Revolucionario Estudiantil; and

WHEREAS, Ernesto sought political change in Cuba; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 1962, Ernesto was sentenced to 20 years of forced labor imprisonment on the Isla de Pinos for his views in opposition to the communist regime of Cuba; and

WHEREAS, during his sentence, Ernesto resisted the forced labor imposed upon himself and other prisoners, and ultimately died at the hands of the Cuban communist regime; and

WHEREAS, on August 9, 1964, Ernesto became the first martyr of Cuba's forced labor camps; and

WHEREAS, SW 12th Street from SW 12th Avenue to SW 14th Avenue is a city street located in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Ernesto Diaz Madruga by approving the City of Miami codesignation of SW 12th Street from SW 12th Avenue to SW 14th Avenue as "Ernesto Diaz Madruga Way"; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 5,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Miami codesignation of SW 12th Street from SW 12th Avenue to SW 14th Avenue as "Ernesto Diaz Madruga Way".

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the City Manager of the City of Miami, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the City of Miami Police Department and the City of Miami Fire-Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION CODESIGNATING SOUTHWEST 12TH STREET FROM SOUTHWEST 12TH AVENUE TO SOUTHWEST 14TH AVENUE, MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS "ERNESTO DIAZ MADRUGA WAY"; FURTHER DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE HEREIN DESIGNATED OFFICES.

WHEREAS, at the age of twenty two (22), Ernesto Diaz Madruga was a young worker at the Central Corazon de Jesus in Cuba, and a member of the "Directorio Revolucionario Estudiantil"; and

WHEREAS, Ernesto Diaz Madruga strived for political change in Cuba, but was met with unjust retribution and ultimately sentenced to twenty (20) years of forced labor imprisonment for his views in opposition of the communist regime; and

WHEREAS, during his sentence, he resisted the forced labor involved in the Camilo Cienfuegos Work Plan being imposed upon prisoners, and met an untimely death at the hands of the communist regime; and

WHEREAS, on August 9, 1964, at the Isla de Pinos, Cuba, Ernesto Diaz Madruga became the first Martyr of the forced labor camps of Cuba;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The recitals and findings contained in the Preamble to this Resolution are adopted by reference and incorporated as fully set forth in this Section.

Section 2. Southwest 12th Street from Southwest 12th Avenue to Southwest 14th Avenue, Miami, Florida, is codesignated as "Ernesto Diaz Madruga Way."

Section 3. The City Manager is directed to instruct the City Clerk to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the City of Miami Departments of Police, Fire-Rescue, and Solid Waste, as well as the Miami-Dade County Public Works/Waste Management Department and the United States Postal Service.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and signature of the Mayor.{1}
