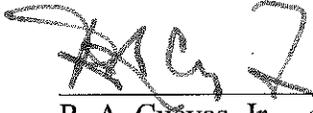

RESOLUTION DIRECTING COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO CONDUCT A FULL REVIEW, PRIOR TO RE-PROCUREMENT OF REPLACEMENT CONTRACTS FOR GOODS OR SERVICES OF THE SCOPES OF SERVICES OR GOODS REQUESTED TO ENSURE SUCH CONTRACTS REFLECT THE CURRENT NEEDS OF THE COUNTY, TO INCLUDE INFORMATION IN RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE BOARD, AND TO CONSULT WITH THE SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT DIVISION REGARDING SOLICITATION AND CONTRACT LANGUAGE

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County is one of the largest purchasers of goods and services in South Florida; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to ensure that all businesses have an equal opportunity to bid on County contracts for goods and services; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to ensure that the scopes of County contracts accurately reflect the current needs of the County; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires that, prior to the re-procurement of a replacement contract for an existing contract ~~[[or an extension of a contract term beyond the original authorization from this Board]]~~¹, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall undertake a full review the scope of services or requested goods solicited by the County to ensure that the scope accurately reflects the County's current needs; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires that such review be undertaken in conjunction with any and all user departments of such contract; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that the Small Business Development Division review all such scopes of service or requested goods to ensure that all information included in the solicitation is current and necessary to the County's solicitation of such goods or service,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to conduct, prior to the re-procurement of a replacement contract for an existing contract ~~[[or an extension of a contract term beyond the original authorization from this Board]]~~, a full review of the scopes of services and/or requested goods set forth in the replacement solicitation ~~[[or current contract]]~~ to ensure that the request accurately reflects the County's current needs. Such review shall be conducted with any and all user departments of the goods or services sought to be procured by the prospective contract~~[[or extension]]~~. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is further directed to include in all recommendations to this Board for a replacement contract ~~[[or extension of a current contract]]~~ a detailed description of the review conducted and identify any updates to the scope of service or goods requested from the previous contract. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is also directed to consult with the Small Business Development Division to ensure that all information included in the replacement solicitation is current and necessary to the County's solicitation of such good or service.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

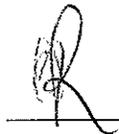
