Subject: Miami-Dade Transit Ridership Report (September 2014)

Attached is the Miami-Dade Transit Monthly Ridership Report across all modes for September 2014. The current fiscal reporting period spans twelve months of ridership data since the last fare increase took effect on October 1, 2013.

For the reporting period of September 2014, overall system average daily ridership was lower compared to the September 2013 period, with a 2.3 percent decrease. This was generated by a 4 percent decrease in average weekday bus boardings, for which the 2.4 percent increase in Metrorail average weekday boardings and the 1.3 percent increase in Metromover average weekday boardings, compared with September 2013, cannot compensate. STS realized a decrease of 2.5 percent over the same timeframe.

The largest increases in average weekday Metrorail boardings from September 2013 to September 2014 were registered at the following stations:

Dadeland North	6.6%	453
Palmetto	19.7%	263
Government Center	1.7%	210

The largest increase in average weekday Metrobus boardings from September 2013 to September 2014 was registered on the following route:
