**Subject:** Recommendation for Approval to Award: A/C Chillers, Auxiliary Equipment, Water Treatment Full Service Contract

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve award of *Contract No. FB-00123, Chillers, Auxiliary Equipment, Water Treatment Full Service Contract* to multiple vendors for turnkey maintenance and water treatment services for air conditioning chillers and auxiliary equipment (i.e., cooling towers, condensate and chilled water pumps, and air compressors) located at various Aviation Department facilities. There are two (2) Groups included in the solicitation: Group 1 - Full Service Maintenance Contract for Various Aviation Facilities and Group 2 - Purchase, Replacement and Installation of Capital Equipment Pre-Qualification.

Under Group 1, the awarded vendors are required to deliver a comprehensive preventive maintenance program per awarded facility, including all necessary labor, transportation, material, and equipment for the safe operation of chiller, cooling towers, pumps and air compressors. In addition to equipment maintenance, the awardees shall institute a complete water treatment program needed to protect air conditioning and heating equipment and piping from deterioration. Under Group 2, the County may purchase, replace, and install capital equipment through spot market quotes among prequalified vendors on an as needed basis at any awarded site

## Scope

The impact of this item is countywide in nature.

## Fiscal Impact and Funding Sources

The fiscal impact for the six-year term is \$8,223,000. The recommended contract consolidates two (2) contracts for these services: (a) 6046-2/12 (A/C Chillers and Related Equipment Maintenance and Repair Services) valued at \$11,864,254 for seven (7) years, which covers only chiller and related Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning (HVAC) equipment maintenance services; and (b) TBW9742-1/14 (Boiler and Chilled Water Chemical Treatment Services) valued at \$567,600 for one (1) year and nine (9) months, which covers water treatment services for chiller and related HVAC equipment.

The recommended replacement contract only covers services for Aviation Department facilities, which require a more comprehensive, Aviation-specific HVAC maintenance and water treatment services program. A separate contract has been developed for other County departments to access for these services.

**Delegated Authority**

If this item is approved, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee will have the authority to exercise all provisions of the contract pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the County Code and Implementing Order 3-38.

**Vendors Recommended for Award**

An Invitation to Bid was issued under full and open competition on August 28, 2014. Seven (7) vendors responded to the solicitation. The method of award for Group 1 was to the lowest-priced responsible, responsive bidder per site in the aggregate who met the solicitation's requirements. The method of award for Group 2 was to pre-qualify all responsive and responsible vendors that met the minimum requirements as specified in the solicitation for participation in future spot market competitions. A list of awardees by site for Group 1 and prequalified vendors for Group 2 is attached.


**Due Diligence**

- The Living Wage Ordinance does not apply.
- The Responsible Wages Ordinance applies to this contract as it is classified as a construction project under the CSBE Program.
