RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE, SUBJECT TO FUNDING AVAILABILITY, TO COMPETITIVELY SELECT, SUBJECT TO BOARD APPROVAL, A VENDOR TO INSTALL ELECTRONIC ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEMS OR SIMILAR SECURITY SYSTEM AT ROBERT KING HIGH, HALEY SOFGE AND MARTIN FINE VILLAS PUBLIC HOUSING SITES; AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE COUNTY MAYOR' DESIGNEE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT A REPORT ADVISING THE BOARD WHETHER FUNDS HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED FOR THIS PURPOSE, THE SOURCE OF SUCH FUNDS, WHETHER A SOLICITATION HAS BEEN ISSUED, AND THE TIMEFRAME FOR COMPLETION OF THE WORK

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County ("County") is a public housing authority and the owner and operator of 12 public housing asset management projects, including, but not limited to, Robert King High, Haley Sofge and Martin Fine Villas public housing sites; and

WHEREAS, Robert King High, Haley Sofge and Martin Fine Villas public housing sites primarily house elderly and disabled tenants; and

WHEREAS, as a public housing authority, the County's paramount goal is to provide decent, safe and sanitary housing for all of its public housing tenants; and

WHEREAS, public housing oftentimes can be difficult to secure because so many families require access to the complex; and

WHEREAS, this Board believes that to ensure for the safety of the most vulnerable public housing tenants, i.e. elderly and disabled public housing tenants, the County must consider installing an access control system for public housing sites like Robert King High, Haley Sofge and Martin Fine Villas public housing sites; and

WHEREAS, using an access control system would allow the County's housing department, Public Housing and Community Development, to carefully regulate which residents and nonresidents can access specific areas of a public housing site; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to have electronic access control systems or similar security systems installed in all public housing sites owned and operated by the County, including electronic access control systems or similar security systems that monitor the entrance of the buildings, the amenities, as well as the residents' units; and

WHEREAS, this Board understands that there are limited federal funds available to install such electronic access control systems or similar security systems in every public housing development; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to start with the installation of such electronic access control systems or similar security systems at Robert King High, Haley Sofge and Martin Fine Villas public housing sites; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to direct the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee, subject to funding availability, to competitively select, subject to Board approval, a vendor to install electronic access control systems or similar security systems at Robert King High, Haley Sofge and Martin Fine Villas public housing sites,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Incorporates and approves the foregoing recitals as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Directs the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee, subject to funding availability, to competitively select, subject to Board approval, a vendor to install access control systems or similar security systems at Robert King High, Haley Sofge and Martin Fine

Villas public housing sites, including electronic access control systems or similar security systems that monitor the entrance of the buildings, the amenities, as well as the residents' units.

Section 3. Directs the County Mayor or the County Mayor to prepare and submit a report to this Board that advises whether funds have been identified for the purposes set forth in Section 2 of this resolution, the source of such funds, whether a solicitation has been issued, and the timeframe for completion of the work. The County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee shall provide the report to this Board within 60 days of the effective date of this resolution and shall place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
