Subject: Miami-Dade Transit Ridership Report (November 2014)

Attached is the Miami-Dade Transit Monthly Ridership Report across all modes for November 2014. The current fiscal reporting period spans fourteen months of ridership data since the last fare increases took effect October 2013.

For the reporting period of November 2014, overall system average daily ridership was lower compared to the November 2013 period, with a 2.97 percent decrease. This was generated by a 4.74 percent decrease in average weekday Metrobus boardings and a 1.26 percent decrease in Metromover average weekday boardings, for which the 2.13 percent Metrorail increase (compared with November 2013) could not compensate. STS realized a decrease of 1.46 percent over the same timeframe.

It should be noted that the decrease in November was primarily caused by early closings (9:00pm) for track maintenance.

The largest increases in average weekday Metrorail boardings from November 2013 to November 2014 were registered at the following stations:

The largest increases in average weekday Metrobus boardings from November 2013 to November 2014 were registered on the following routes:

Route 36 (Omni to International Mall & Dolphin Mall via 36th st)	7.2%	213
