**Subject:** Miami-Dade Transit Ridership Report (December 2014)

Attached is the Miami-Dade Transit Monthly Ridership Report across all modes for December 2014. The current fiscal reporting period spans fifteen months of ridership data since the last fare increases took effect October 2013.

For the reporting period of December 2014, overall system average daily ridership was lower compared to the December 2013 period, with a 1.52 percent decrease. This was generated by a 3.23 percent decrease in average weekday Metrobus boardings, for which the 2.63 percent increase in Metrorail average weekday boardings, and the 2.60 percent increase in Metromover average weekday boardings (compared with December 2013) could not compensate. STS realized a decrease of 2.10 percent over the same timeframe.

The largest increases in average weekday Metrorail boardings from December 2013 to December 2014 were registered at the following stations:

The largest increases in average weekday Metrobus boardings from December 2013 to December 2014 were registered on the following routes:
