Subject: Miami-Dade Transit Ridership Report (October 2014)

Attached is the Miami-Dade Transit Monthly Ridership Report across all modes for October 2014. The current fiscal reporting period spans thirteen months of ridership data since the last fare increases took effect October 2013.

For the reporting period of October 2014, overall system average daily ridership was lower compared to the October 2013 period, with a 3.0 percent decrease. This was generated by a 5.5 percent decrease in average weekday Metrobus boardings, for which the 3.1 percent increase in Metrorail average weekday boardings and the 2.5 percent increase in Metromover average weekday boardings (compared with October 2013) could not compensate. STS realized a decrease of 0.8 percent over the same timeframe.

The largest increases in average weekday Metrorail boardings from October 2013 to October 2014 were registered at the following stations:

| Metrorail Station Average Weekday Boardings | Percentage Increase | Boardings Increase |
|---|---------------------|--------------------|
| Brickell | 11.2% | 625 |
| Government Center | 5.2% | 612 |
| Dadeland North | 6.1% | 429 |

The largest increases in average weekday Metrobus boardings from October 2013 to October 2014 were registered on the following route:

| Metrobus Route Average Weekday Boardings | Percentage Increase | Boardings Increase |
|--|---------------------|--------------------|
| Route 36 (Omni to International Mall & Dolphin Mall via 36th st) | 11.1% | 346 |
| Route 150 (Miami Airport Metrorail to South Dr. - South Beach) | 18.2% | 239 |
