## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that, pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the Miami-Dade County Code, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached resolution awarding Contract No. W-927 to Lanzo Construction Co., Florida for a project entitled "Southwest Wellfield Removal of Calcium Carbonate from the Middle Lagoon." The total compensation amount is not to exceed \$12,772,258 for a contract term of 750 days with no options-to-renew. This recommendation to award was prepared by the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD).

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** This project consists of furnishing all materials, labor and equipment necessary to remove calcium carbonate residuals from the middle lagoon of the Southwest Wellfield, located at 8601 SW 127 Avenue, Section 35, Township 54, Range 39, Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Calcium carbonate residual is the material removed from the basins at the Alexander Orr, Jr. Water Treatment Plant during the water softening process. The material is inert and non-toxic, and in its dry stage it is a very fine powder.

The scope of work for this project includes, but is not limited to:

- Clearing, grubbing, excavating, loading, hauling and legally disposing of calcium carbonate residuals in trucks with watertight bodies and covers.
- Hauling away approximately 612,000 cubic yards of calcium carbonate and legally disposing of the material at an offsite location provided by the Contractor.
- Performing street cleaning along the calcium carbonate haul route.
- Breaching the existing dike and reconstructing the dike with new limerock material at the completion of work.
- Operating and maintaining a truck wash station for the duration of the project.
- Furnishing and installing limerock fill as required.
- Traffic control, survey work, compliance with security restrictions.
- Restoration of any areas affected by the work.
- All other miscellaneous and appurtenant items and work to make for a complete and satisfactory project.

**EXPLANATION:** On December 3, 2014, an advertisement for sealed bids was published for this project. On January 30, 2015, WASD received five (5) bids. The lowest and second lowest bids were 4 percent and 2 percent less than the Engineer's base estimate, respectively. WASD's recommendation is to award this construction contract to the lowest bidder, Lanzo Construction Co., Florida, who was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

The Internal Services Department's Capital Improvements Information System database contains 17 final evaluations dating back to March 2008 through March 2015 for Lanzo Construction Co., Florida with an average overall rating of 3.5 out of a possible 4 points, which is indicative of overall satisfactory performance. In addition, there are three (3) stand-alone evaluations which are not in the Internal Services Department's Capital Improvements Information System database for three (3) emergency projects in which Lanzo Construction Co., Florida provided repair services. The average overall rating for these emergency repair projects is 3.5 points out of a possible 4 points.

Due diligence was conducted in accordance with the Internal Services Department's Procurement Guidelines to determine responsibility, including verifying corporate status and performance and compliance data. The lists reviewed include: convicted vendors, debarred vendors, delinquent contractors, suspended vendors, and federal excluded parties. There were no adverse findings relating to the contractor's responsibility. This information is being provided pursuant to Resolution R-187-12.

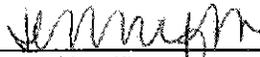
**BACKGROUND:** WASD's Alexander Orr, Jr. Water Treatment Plant has been in operation since the early 1950s. It provides potable water to most in the southern portion of Miami-Dade County. The Plant treats hard raw water to permitted drinking water standards and produces approximately 72,000 cubic yards of calcium carbonate residuals as a byproduct of the water softening process during treatment. Calcium carbonate is a harmless calcium and magnesium concentration. It is pumped into sludge lagoons located at Department's Southwest Wellfield for temporary storage. At the present time, the middle lagoon, which has been in service for over 35 years, is reaching full capacity.

The scope of work in this contract award recommendation provides for the removal of approximately 612,000 cubic yards of calcium carbonate residuals, which will provide the adequate storage capacity needed for the Department to continue its disposal operations at the Southwest Wellfield. The calcium carbonate residuals will be hauled away and legally disposed at an offsite location provided by the Contractor and approved by the County's Regulatory and Economic Resources Department.

**Reasons for Recommendation**

This project is a resubmittal from 5/22/2014 due to a change in the project title and a decrease in the estimated cost from \$13,590,050.00 to \$13,383,350.00. As a result, the CSBE Goal was reduced from 15.70% to 14.45%.

An analysis of the factors contained in Section VI C of Implementing Order 3-22 indicates that a CSBE Subcontractor Goal is appropriate in the trades of: site preparation contractors 3.78% (clearing, grubbing, access road, & grading); other heavy and civil engineering construction 10.14% (excavation & hauling); and all other specialty trade contractors .53% (truck washer & meter).

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The Small Business Development (SBD) Division has completed its review of the subject project for compliance with the Small Business Enterprise/Construction (SBE/Construction) Program for Construction Services. The contract measure applicable to this project is a 14.45% SBE/Construction Goal.

The Construction Contracts Section of Miami-Dade Water & Sewer Department has submitted bid documents from Lanzo Construction Co., Metro Equipment Service, Inc., and G7 Holdings, Inc. for compliance review.

## SUMMARY:

Lanzo Construction Co. (#1), submitted a Schedule of Intent (SOI) Affidavit committing to utilize Pro Service Group, LLC, a certified SBE/Construction firm, to perform excavation work at 14.45%. The subcontractor signed its respective SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. Lanzo Construction Co. is in compliance with the Implementing Order for the SBE/Construction Program for the purchase of Construction Services.

Metro Equipment Service, Inc. (#2), submitted a Schedule of Intent (SOI) Affidavit committing to utilize Kailas Corp. dba Kailas Contractors, a certified SBE/Construction firm, to perform trucking and hauling work at 14.45%. The subcontractor signed its respective SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. Metro Equipment Service, Inc. is in compliance with the Implementing Order for the SBE/Construction Program for the purchase of Construction Services.

G7 Holdings, Inc. (#3), a certified SBE/Construction firm, submitted the required Schedule of Intent (SOI) Affidavit committing to perform 100% of the scope of work. As a certified SBE/Construction firm G7 Holdings, Inc. may meet up to 50% of the SBE/Construction goal with its own forces. As an SOI Affidavit was not submitted to identify another SBE/Construction firm to meet up to 50% of the SBE/Construction goal, G7 Holdings, Inc. failed to meet the SBE/Construction goal requirement for this project. SBD notified G7 Holdings, Inc. in writing that its bid documents submitted did not comply with the SBE/Construction measures applied to the contract. The firm did not request a meeting to provide additional documentation and clarification to assist in the compliance review. As such, G7 Holdings, Inc. is not in compliance with the Implementing Order for the SBE/Construction Program.

Related parties shall mean bidders or proposers or the principals, corporate officers, and managers thereof which have a direct or indirect ownership interest in another bidder or proposer for the same agreement or in which a parent company or the principals thereof of one (1) bidder or proposer have a direct or indirect ownership interest in another bidder or proposer for the same agreement. Bids or proposals found to be collusive shall be rejected.

## CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_\_, by and between Miami-Dade County, Florida, acting by and through the Office of the Mayor, party of the first part (hereinafter sometimes called the "County"), and Lanzo Construction Co., Florida, party of the second part (hereinafter sometimes called "Contractor");

### WITNESSETH

That the parties hereto, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, mutually agree as follows, to wit:

1. That the Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials and equipment and perform all work in the manner and form provided by the Contract Documents covering the Project of the County known and identified as

for the aggregate amount reflected by the Proposal, said aggregate amount being of Twelve Million Seven Hundred Seventy Two Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Eight Dollars and No Cents (U.S. Dollars) \$12,772,258.00.

It is further mutually agreed that if at any time after the execution of this Contract, Surety Performance and Payment Bond, the County shall deem the surety upon such bonds to be unsatisfactory, or if for any reason such bond shall become inadequate to cover the performance of the work, the Contractor shall at his own expense, within five (5) days after the receipt of notice from the County to do so, furnish an additional bond or bonds in such form and amount and with such surety or sureties as shall be satisfactory to the County. In such event, no further payment to the Contractor shall be deemed to be due under this Contract until such new or additional security shall have been furnished in a manner and form satisfactory to the County.
