

Subject: Miami-Dade Transit Ridership Report (January 2015)

Attached is the Miami-Dade Transit Monthly Ridership Report across all modes for January 2015.

For the reporting period of January 2015, the overall system average daily ridership was slightly higher (0.6 percent) as compared to January 2014. For the same reporting period, Metrorail and Metromover average weekday boardings increased by 4.4 percent and 1.9 percent, respectively. Metrobus average weekday boardings decreased by 0.6 percent and STS realized an increase of one (1) percent over the same timeframe.

The largest increases in average weekday Metrorail boardings from January 2014 to January 2015 were registered at the following stations:

Metrorail Station Average Weekday Boardings	Percentage Increase	Boardings Increase
Brickell	13.8%	770
Dadeland North	4.4%	311

The largest increases in average weekday Metrobus boardings from January 2014 to January 2015 were registered on the following routes:

Metrobus Route Average Weekday Boardings	Percentage Increase	Boardings Increase
Route 7 (Downtown to International Mall and Dolphin Mall via NW 7 Street)	10.7%	454
Route 51 (Downtown to SW 137 Avenue/8 Street via Flagler – Limited Stop)	11.3%	392
Route 3 (Downtown to Aventura via Biscayne Boulevard)	4.6%	370
Route 150 (Miami Airport Metrorail to South Drive – South Beach)	24.6%	335
