



Subject: Report on Implementation Plan for a Snapper Creek Linear Park from Sunset Drive to Biscayne Bay – Directive 142482

At the January 21, 2015 Board of County Commissioners (Board) meeting, the Board approved Resolution No. R-51-15 (Attachment 1) sponsored by Commissioner Javier D. Souto directing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to prepare a report containing an implementation plan for a Snapper Creek Linear Park from Sunset Drive to Biscayne Bay to include estimated costs, potential funding sources and a timeline for construction if applicable.

Introduction and Background

The Linear Park is partially developed, currently commencing at Tamiami Park, running south along Snapper Creek Canal, and terminating at Sunset Drive (SW 72 Street) and SW 107 Avenue. The attached map (Attachment 2) depicts the Snapper Creek Linear Park as contemplated by Resolution R-51-15. This legislation proposes a segment beginning at the termination point of the existing trail and proceeding to Biscayne Bay. The implementation plan to continue the linear park is described in the attached chart (Attachment 3). Conceptual cost estimates totaling \$2.48 million are provided in Attachment 3 for the segments that have been studied. As studies are completed, cost estimates will be developed for these segments.

Potential Funding

No current funding is available for any portion of the Snapper Creek Linear Park. Miami-Dade County may make a 2016 application for the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funding upon completion of the Metropolitan Planning Office's (MPO) Master Plan Study expected to be completed in early 2016. Having a planning study completed increases the likelihood of receiving TAP funding. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District 6 TAP awards are limited to \$1 million funding requests, for up to \$3 million in total funding per project. The Snapper Creek Linear Park projects could be divided into multiple phases that may become separately eligible for up to \$3 million each. Matching funds are recommended at a minimum 20 percent of project costs to apply for TAP grants. Matching funds for these projects have not been identified, therefore additional County appropriations are required to support successful grant applications.

Timeline for Construction

The earliest completion date for any portion of a Snapper Creek Linear Park is 2019 if funding were to be made available by early 2016. If the project is required to be divided into multiple phases, full build-out may be achievable by 2025. Assuming continuous TAP funding, the development cycle is approximately four years.

Conclusion and Recommended Next Steps


A Snapper Creek Linear Park, as described within Resolution R-51-15, has the potential to enhance mobility and to serve as a significant recreational asset for the citizens of Miami-Dade County. Upon

completion of the Planning Study mentioned above, the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department will review the phasing plan and probable costs, and working with the MPO, will develop a program to advance the Snapper Creek Trail/Snapper Creek Linear Park.

Per Ordinance 14-65, this memorandum will be placed on the next available Board of County Commissioners meeting agenda.



RESOLUTION NO. R-51-15

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PREPARE A REPORT
CONTAINING AN IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR A
SNAPPER CREEK LINEAR PARK FROM SUNSET DRIVE TO
BISCAYNE BAY

WHEREAS, this Board has previously directed that the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee prepare a report regarding implementation of an initiative to transform various lands underneath the MetroRail right-of-way into a contiguous ten-mile walkway, bike path, linear park, and transit mobility corridor from the Miami River north of the Brickell MetroRail Station to the Dadeland South MetroRail Station known as "The Underline" project; and

WHEREAS, the creation of an additional linear park along Snapper Creek Canal from Sunset Drive to Biscayne Bay, the "Snapper Creek Linear Park," connecting with The Underline, will increase usage for both projects as well as be the first step in the creation of a linked network of linear parks which promote recreation activities as well as enhanced urban mobility; and

WHEREAS, the creation of linear parks is consistent with the 2008 Miami-Dade County Parks and Open Spaces System Master Plan by enhancing the County's system of parks, public spaces, natural and cultural areas connected by greenways, waterways, trails and linear parks in order to create a healthier, greener and a more economically vibrant place to live, work and play; and

WHEREAS, the Snapper Creek Linear Park project will result in improvements to social, environmental, and economic conditions in the area under consideration by adding much-needed green space and a transit-connected biking and walking corridor to a heavily-populated area; and

WHEREAS, as with The Underline, a Snapper Creek Linear Park will provide an urban restoration of natural habitats for plant and animal life in a park setting; and

WHEREAS, as the area under consideration is adjacent to Snapper Creek and potentially involves use of County-owned right-of-way, the County should take a leadership role in planning and promoting this project; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to review an implementation plan prepared by the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee which details how a Snapper Creek Linear Park can be realized, along with the cost, potential funding sources, and a timeline for construction,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is directed to prepare a report containing an implementation plan for a Snapper Creek linear park from Sunset Drive to Biscayne Bay which includes, at a minimum, the cost, potential funding sources and a timeline for construction. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall provide the report to this Board within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution and shall place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Esteban L. Bovo, Jr.**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
