RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THE TRAFFIC  
ROUNDBOUT AT THE INTERSECTION OF NE 199TH  
STREET AND NORTH DRIVE AS "FATHER PETER  
LICKMAN WAY"

**WHEREAS**, the Very Reverend Father Peter Lickman was born in New Philadelphia on April 20, 1943 as the youngest of four children and a son of the late John and Anna Sisak Lickman; and

**WHEREAS**, after graduating from Nativity BVM High School and Duquesne University, Father Lickman continued his theological studies at Ss. Cyril and Methodius Seminary and at John the XXIII Centre at Fordham University; and

**WHEREAS**, Father Lickman was ordained a priest by Bishop Stephen Kocisko on June 9, 1968 in Passaic, New York; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1971, Father Lickman became the pastor of St. Basil Byzantine Catholic Church in North Miami Beach, where he served loyally for over forty years until his passing on March 4, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, whether it was tending to the garden, walking his dogs, or conversing with members of the congregation, Father Lickman was always active in his community; and

**WHEREAS**, Father Lickman will be remembered as a man who was devoted to his parishioners and his community, and who was always there to help anyone in need; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor the memory of Father Lickman and his contributions to the community by codesignating the traffic roundabout at the intersection of NE 199th Street and North Drive as "Father Peter Lickman Way"; and

**WHEREAS**, St. Basil Catholic Church is located at 1475 NE 199th Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the traffic roundabout at the intersection of NE 199th Street and North Drive is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 1,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates the traffic roundabout at the intersection of NE 199th Street and North Drive as “Father Peter Lickman Way”.

**Section 2.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan. It was offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
