Subject: Recommendation to Reject Bids Received: Prisoner Transport Buses

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the rejection of the bids received in response to solicitation *FB-00185, Prisoner Transport Buses* for the Miami-Dade Corrections and Rehabilitation Department. The purpose of the solicitation was to establish a contract for purchase of eight (8) high-security, model year 2015 rear engine prisoner transport buses.

The department has an inventory of 17 buses to transport prisoners to and from correctional facilities throughout the County and the State of Florida. Four (4) of the buses were recently retired and another four (4) are in service, but near the end of their useful life. These eight (8) buses have been approved for replacement to bring the fleet back to the full inventory necessary to meet operational needs.

The solicitation's technical specifications required the awardee to provide buses capable of transporting a minimum of 44 prisoners. Two (2) responses were received, of which one (1) was a "No Bid." The other response failed to comply with the technical specifications, as the bidder offered the County buses with only a 30-person seating capacity. Moreover, the bidder's proposed unit price exceeded the allocation budgeted by the Miami-Dade Corrections and Rehabilitation Department.

Following approval of this rejection recommendation, the Corrections and Rehabilitation Department will consider re-issuing the solicitation or accessing another entity's contract for prisoner transport buses.

Scope

The impact of this item would have been countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact of the one-time purchase was estimated at \$1,600,000.
