RESOLUTION APPROVING THE STATE ROAD
CODESIGNATION OF STATE ROAD 934/EAST 25TH
STREET BETWEEN EAST 8TH AVENUE AND EAST 9TH
AVENUE AS "TOMAS-MINERVA VINUELA WAY"

WHEREAS, during the 2014 legislative session, Chapter 2014–228, Laws of Florida (Senate Bill 820), was enacted which, among other codesignations, codesignated State Road 934/East 25th Street between East 8th Avenue and East 9th Avenue as "Tomas-Minerva Vinuela Way"; and

WHEREAS, Tomas and Minerva Vinuela emigrated from Cuba in the 1960s and later founded Hialeah Hardware & Lumber at 851 East 25th Street in Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, more than two decades after founding Hialeah Hardware & Lumber, the Vinuela family continues to own and operate the business; and

WHEREAS, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the installation of state road designation signs shall be contingent on the applicable county or city commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary road designation; and

WHEREAS, State Road 934/East 25th Street between East 8th Avenue and East 9th Avenue is a state road located within the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, before the Florida Department of Transportation will install signs reflecting the "Tomas-Minerva Vinuela Way" road codesignation, Miami-Dade County is required to pass a resolution in support of this road designation; and

WHEREAS, this state road codesignation is on the dividing line between County Commission Districts 13 and 6,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the state road codesignation of State Road 934/East 25th Street between East 8th Avenue and East 9th Avenue as “Tomas-Minerva Vinuela Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Hialeah Police Department and the Hialeah Fire Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Vice Chairman Esteban L. Bovo, Jr. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

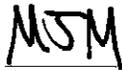
