RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF SE 6TH AVENUE
BETWEEN U.S. 1 AND CAMPBELL DRIVE AS "VFW
ARRANT-SMITH POST 4127 AVENUE"

WHEREAS, John Anderson Arrant and Earl Smith, residents of the City of Homestead, were sailors on the USS Arizona Battleship in 1941; and

WHEREAS, on December 7, 1941, Arrant and Smith perished in the line of duty while stationed on the USS Arizona, as a result of the bombing of Pearl Harbor; and

WHEREAS, in 1945, the Veterans of Foreign Wars chartered the local Arrant-Smith Post 4127 in the City of Homestead in honor of the ultimate sacrifices Arrant and Smith made for their country; and

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2015, the Homestead City Council adopted Resolution No. R2015-06-70, which codesignated SE 6th Avenue between U.S. 1 and Campbell Drive as "VFW Arrant-Smith Post 4127 Avenue", in recognition of the brave service of John Anderson Arrant and Earl Smith to the City of Homestead and their country, and in further recognition of the outstanding civic and community work of Arrant-Smith Post 4127; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution No. R2015-06-70 is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, Veterans of Foreign Wars Arrant-Smith Post 4127 is located at 601 NE 2nd Road in the City of Homestead; and

WHEREAS, that portion of SE 6th Avenue between U.S. 1 and Campbell Drive is a city street located in the City of Homestead; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homestead wants the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 8;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Homestead codesignation of SE 6th Avenue between U.S. 1 and Campbell Drive as “VFW Arrant-Smith Post 4127 Avenue”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Homestead City Council, the Homestead City Manager, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Homestead Police Department and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:



RESOLUTION NO. R2015-06-70

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA, **CODESIGNATING SE 6th AVENUE BETWEEN US 1 AND CAMPBELL DRIVE AS "VFW ARRANT-SMITH POST 4127 AVENUE"** IN HONOR OF **SAILORS JOHN ANDERSON ARRANT AND EARL SMITH;** PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, John Anderson Arrant and Earl Smith, residents of the City of Homestead, were sailors on the USS Arizona Battleship in 1941; and

WHEREAS, Sailors Arrant and Smith perished in the line of duty on December 7, 1941 while stationed on the USS Arizona, as result of the bombing of Pearl Harbor; and

WHEREAS, local post 4127 of the Veterans of Foreign War was chartered in the City of Homestead in 1945, dedicated to the ultimate sacrifices Sailors Arrant and Smith made for their country; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of their brave service to the City of Homestead and their country, the City Council desires to co-designate a street in their names, while also recognizing the outstanding civic and community work of Post 4127.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That the above stated recitals are hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. Street Co-Designation. That in recognition of the outstanding dedication and service rendered by John Anderson Arrant and Earl Smith to the citizens of Homestead and to this great nation, and the wonderful community and civic work of

Post 4127 at its 70th anniversary, the City of Homestead formally co-designates, in perpetuity, SE 6th Avenue between US 1 and Campbell Drive as "VFW Arrant-Smith Post 4127 Avenue".

Section 3. Implementation. That the appropriate departments of the City of Homestead are hereby authorized and directed to implement the purpose of this Resolution by erecting the appropriate street signs, subject to any and all necessary coordination with or approval from Miami-Dade County.


Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption hereof.


