

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE JUNE 19, JULY 2, JULY 17, JULY 31, AND AUGUST 14, 2015 "CITY OF WEST MIAMI SUMMER CAMP FIELD TRIPS" SPONSORED BY THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,212.50 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 6 FY 2014-15 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the June 19, July 2, July 17, July 31, and August 14, 2015 "City of West Miami Summer Camp Field Trips" in an amount not to exceed \$1,212.50 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the "City of West Miami Summer Camp Field Trips" will take place in Crandon Park; and

WHEREAS, the "City of West Miami Summer Camp Field Trips" are district events, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$1,212.50 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the balance of the District 6 FY 2014-15 In-Kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the June 19, July 2, July 17, July 31, and August 14, 2015 "City of West Miami Summer Camp Field Trips" sponsored by the City of West Miami in an amount not to exceed \$1,212.50 to be funded from the balance of District 6 FY 2014-15 In-Kind Reserve Fund.

We have been in contact with Crandon Park to reserve Pavilion #6 for five summer camp events this coming summer.

The dates intended are Friday, June 19th; Thursday, July 2nd; Friday, July 17th; Friday, July 31st and Friday, August 14th.

In addition to food, beverage, picnic supplies and transportation costs there are rental and parking fees that are charged by Miami-Dade County that add to the total cost of the trip.

The total County expenses include five pavilion rentals of \$84.00 and bus and truck parking fees of \$52.00 per trip.

We keep our charge per child at a break-even amount on these trips to provide a great day and great food to as many children as possible.

With this in mind, I am asking you to contact District 6 Commissioner Rebeca Sosa to see if a waiver of pavilion and parking fees could be obtained from Miami-Dade County for these trips.
