

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO INFORM THE COUNTY COMMISSIONER OR COMMISSIONERS WHENEVER A REPRESENTATIVE OF A MUNICIPALITY OR A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ORGANIZATION LOCATED IN THAT COMMISSIONER'S DISTRICT OR COMMISSIONERS' DISTRICTS CONTACTS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY MAYOR'S ADMINISTRATION REQUESTING THAT AN ACTION BE TAKEN WITHIN SUCH COMMISSIONER'S DISTRICT OR COMMISSIONERS' DISTRICTS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is the legislative and governing body of Miami-Dade County and is responsible for, among other things, the provision of metropolitan services such as emergency management, airport and seaport operations, public housing and health care services, transportation, environmental services, solid waste disposal, as well as police and fire protection; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the unincorporated areas, Miami-Dade County is comprised of 34 municipalities, each of which has its own government and provides city services such as zoning protection; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the various municipalities, including staff, lobbyists and attorneys, as well as representatives of various public and private organizations, often contact members of the County Mayor's administration requesting that certain actions be taken within such municipalities or within the nearby unincorporated areas; and

WHEREAS, County Commissioners have a great deal of interest in being kept timely aware of such requests from municipalities and public or private organizations located in their districts, in order to facilitate the Commissioners' ability to address the issues and concerns raised by such municipalities and organizations; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore in the best interest of the County that the County Mayor or Mayor's designee inform the County Commissioner or Commissioners whenever a representative of a municipality or a public or private organization located in that Commissioner's district or Commissioners' districts contacts a member of the County Mayor's administration requesting that an action be taken within such Commissioner's district or Commissioners' districts,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to inform the County Commissioner or Commissioners whenever a representative of a municipality or a public or private organization located in that Commissioner's district or Commissioners' districts contacts a member of the County Mayor's administration requesting that an action be taken within such Commissioner's district or Commissioners' districts.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
