

RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION RENAMING, AFTER A PUBLIC HEARING, WEST KENDALL DISTRICT PARK AS "WEST END DISTRICT PARK"

WHEREAS, West Kendall District Park, located at 11255 Southwest 157th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33196, is one of the parks managed by the Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department; and

WHEREAS, as a 164-acre park, West Kendall District Park is a "district park" under the Recreation & Open Space Element of the Comprehensive Development Master Plan (the "CDMP"); and

WHEREAS, under the CDMP, district parks are intended to satisfy the recreational and open-space needs of the 5-mile area surrounding the park; and

WHEREAS, the 5-mile area surrounding the park includes areas commonly known as The Hammocks, Country Walk, and Kendale Lakes, among others; and

WHEREAS, renaming West Kendall District Park as "West End District Park," would be more inclusive of all of the areas serviced by the park; and

WHEREAS, the Florida International University College of Architecture and the Arts, the Florida International University College of Engineering & Computing, and the Florida International University Metropolitan Center completed the study titled "West End Strategy: A Vision for the Future" (the "West End Strategy"); and

WHEREAS, the West End Strategy study fits within and responds to the CDMP; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the West End Strategy included development guidelines, using collective data from the economic analysis and the general assessment of physical conditions, and identified 15 action items in six areas phased as 5- and 10-year increments to allow for strategic planning options; and

~~**WHEREAS**, the six areas emphasized, based on previously collected data, were urban~~
design, economic development, marketing and branding, transportation, landscape, and “placemaking,” with the goal being to improve livability, generate sustainable development, improve the physical and landscape design, and develop a distinctive identity for the West End within the greater Miami area; and

WHEREAS, the renaming would advance the marketing and branding goal of the West End Strategy and would help develop a distinctive identity for the West End within the greater Miami area; and

WHEREAS, Rule 9.02 of the Board’s Rules of Procedure provides that resolutions regarding proposed naming, renaming or co-designation of Miami-Dade County roads, facilities or property shall be sponsored by the district commissioner where the road is located; and

WHEREAS, this renaming is located in County Commission District 11,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, renames West Kendall District Park as “West End District Park”.

Section 2. Directs the Mayor or designee to revise all references to the West Kendall District Park to “West End District Park,” and to install suitable signage to reflect the renaming.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Juan C. Zapata. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
