

This item was amended at the 10-15-15 Economic Prosperity Committee to change the boundaries of the proposed CRA, takes out the reference to paying for a stadium, and adds in paying for infrastructure, workforce housing, affordable housing, and economic development.

RESOLUTION DIRECTING COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO SELECT A CONSULTANT TO PREPARE A FINDING OF NECESSITY STUDY FOR ORANGE SPORTS COMPLEX COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREA TO INCLUDE THE GEOGRAPHICAL AREA DESCRIBED GENERALLY AS BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY THE MIAMI RIVER, BOUNDED ON THE SOUTH BY SW 8TH STREET, BOUNDED ON THE WEST BY NW 17TH AVENUE AND BOUNDED ON THE EAST BY THE MIAMI RIVER, AND SUCH OTHER SURROUNDING AREAS THAT THE STUDY DETERMINES TO BE NECESSARY; AND PROVIDING FUNDING SOURCE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes (the "Act"), a Finding of Necessity study must be prepared in order to initiate the redevelopment process for areas believed to be slum and blighted; and

WHEREAS, the Act confers all redevelopment powers upon counties with home rule charters and authorizes such counties to delegate the exercise of such powers within the boundaries of a municipality to the governing body of such municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Miami-Dade County, Florida (the "Board") desires to authorize the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to select a consultant to prepare a Finding of Necessity study for the Orange Sports Complex Community Redevelopment Agency ("CRA") in accordance with the provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the finding of Necessity study shall consider whether the CRA could be used to fund: (a) ~~[[the acquisition of any parcels necessary for the construction of a dual purpose stadium (MLS soccer/UM football)]]~~¹ >>infrastructure, affordable housing, workforce housing,

and economic development<<; and (b) the construction of a people mover leg from the Government Center to Little Havana/Stadium site. The Finding of Necessity study should provide for the CRA to sunset once the two projects are fully funded and for Miami-Dade's contribution to the CRA trust fund to be at 50 percent and all other taxing authority's contribution to be 50 percent; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that payment of such expenses for the study are paid for from private sector sources or such other available and appropriate County sources, as determined by the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The matters contained in the foregoing recitals are incorporated in this resolution by reference.

Section 2. The Board hereby directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to select a consultant to prepare a Finding of Necessity study for creation of the Orange Sports Complex community redevelopment area to include the geographical area described generally as bounded on the north by the Miami River, bounded on the south by ~~[[Flagler]]~~ >>SW 8th<< Street, bounded on the west by NW ~~[[22nd]]~~ >>17th<< Avenue and bounded on the east by the Miami River, and such other surrounding areas as determined necessary by the Finding of Necessity study.

Section 3. The Board hereby finds that the source of funding for payment of such consulting fees shall be from private sector sources or such other available and appropriate County sources—which County sources, if used, shall be reimbursed to the County by the CRA upon its creation – as determined by the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
