

RESOLUTION URGING THE CITIZENS' INDEPENDENT TRANSPORTATION TRUST TO INCREASE THE SIZE OF THE LOGOS PLACED ON TROLLEYS AND BUSES PURCHASED IN WHOLE OR IN PART WITH PEOPLE'S TRANSPORTATION PLAN FUNDS AND TO REDESIGN SUCH LOGOS TO FEATURE "MIAMI-DADE COUNTY" PROMINENTLY AND TO PRESENT SUCH REDESIGNED LOGOS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE FOR BOARD APPROVAL BEFORE PLACEMENT ON SUCH TROLLEYS AND BUSES

**WHEREAS**, the half-penny sales surtax used to fund the People's Transportation Plan was approved by the voters of the County as well as this Board; and

**WHEREAS**, currently, all County buses and municipal trolleys purchased in whole or in part using surtax funds contain a logo emphasizing the "Transportation Trust" and the "half-penny" sales tax; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has been integral in approving and administering the funds from the half-penny sales surtax necessary to complete public works projects as well as transportation and transit projects including municipal circulators; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board values the work and leadership of the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust; and

**WHEREAS**, notwithstanding the Trust's work, it is the County that receives the bulk of the comments, complaints, and criticisms that result from the People's Transportation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board believes that the logos placed on buses and trolleys funded in whole or in part with the half-penny surtax provide information to the visitors and residents of the County that their half-penny surtax results in real-world, tangible improvements to their transportation options; and

**WHEREAS**, it is important that the residents and visitors upon seeing the logo on a bus or trolley know immediately that the County had a leadership role in that purchase,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that:

**Section 1.** This Board urges the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust to increase the size of the logos placed on trolleys and buses purchased in whole or in part with People's Transportation Plan funds and to redesign such logos to feature "Miami-Dade County" prominently and to present such redesigned logos to this Board for approval before placement on such trolleys and buses.

**Section 2.** The Clerk of the Board is directed to provide a copy of this resolution to the Chair and Members of the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust.


