



Subject: Social Equity Statement for Ordinance Related to Building Security Cameras; Requiring
Installation and Maintenance of Security Cameras on Commercial Properties

The proposed ordinance is not anticipated to have a specific social equity benefit or burden as described in Ordinance No. 15-83. This proposed ordinance creates a new section of the Code and amends an existing section to require certain occupancy classifications to install and maintain surveillance video cameras.

Although the costs to install and maintain surveillance video cameras will be borne by the specific business, this policy change is expected to provide a safety benefit by deterring criminal activity. A specific benefit or burden is not quantifiable at this time.
